(b) Winner of either a Grade II race or a race of the value of Rs. 8 lakhs or over (other than a graded race) 2 Kgs. or either of two or more such races 3 Kgs.

OR

(c) Winner of either a Grade I race or a race of the value of Rs. 12 lakhs or over (other than a graded race) 4 Kgs. or either of two or more such races 6 Kgs.

(ii) Winner after 30th April, 2010 of a race of the value of Rs. 4 lakhs or over 1 Kg extra; or winner of either two or more such races or a race of the value of Rs. 8 lakhs or over 2 Kgs. extra.

Allowances : Fillies and Mares allowed 1.5 Kgs.

N.B. If the highest weight an acceptor has to carry is less than 60 Kgs. it shall be raised to 60 Kgs. and the other weights shall be raised equally.

Distance : (About) 1800 Metres.

Entrance : Rs.9,600 of the Sweepstakes falls due at 10 a.m. on Monday, 10th May, 2010.

A further Rs. 3,200 falls due for horses not struck out by 10 a.m. on Wednesday, 19th May, 2010 and the final Rs.3,200 for horses not struck out by 10 a.m. on Thursday, 17th June, 2010.

Final Entry : At 10 a.m. on Wednesday, 16th June, 2010 @ Rs. 1,60,000.

Twelve to enter in bona fide separate interests or the above race to be at the option of the Stewards.
