RACING INCIDENTS
(120 - 127)

GOING : Good

PENETROMETER READING: 4.0 Cms.

RAILING POSITION: Railing fixed at average width of 5.0 Meters from 1600 Meters to winning post from its original position.

1st Race: 120. The Sha Tin Plate - Div, II - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 00 to 25, to be ridden by Indian Jockeys Claiming allowance (Whips not allowed) (11 Runners).

Permission was granted to Trainer Mr.S. Dominic to withdraw TOP NEWS on veterinary grounds as it was found to be trotting lame on right fore. He was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

BARONESS (Angad) was slowly away, lost many lengths and did not raise a fluent gallop for the first 100 Metres. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Narayana Gowda V. was informed not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least two Mock Races.

Jockey Ikram Ahmed, the rider of IMMORTAL GUEST was fined Rs.1,000/- for coming 'in' and causing interference to PERFECT HALO (K.G. Likith Appu) on his inside approaching 900 Metres.

Jockey K.G. Likith Appu, the rider of PERFECT HALO was fined Rs.1,000/- for shifting out and bumping IMMORTAL GUEST (Ikram Ahmed) on his outside passing the 900 Metres.

Jockey Tousif Khan, the rider of REGAL FORCE was fined Rs.1,000/- for shifting out and causing interference to RED LUCIFER (Salman Khan) on his outside approaching 700 Metres.

Jockey Ikram Ahmed, the rider of IMMORTAL GUEST was fined Rs.2,000/- for shifting out and causing interference to COMEONSON (S. Saqlain) on his outside approaching 700 Metres.

Jockey Vivek.G, the rider of GOLDEN TIME reported that his saddle shifted back passing the 300 Metres. After due examination of the equipment, Trainer Mr.V. Lokanath was fined Rs.3,000/- for faulty saddling of his charge.

At behest of the owner's written complaint, an enquiry is being held into the running and riding of PORT OF BEAUTY, trained by Mr. M. Rajendra Singh and ridden by Jockey L. Alex Rozario in the above race.

REGAL FORCE (Tousif Khan) sustained bleeding cut injury on right fore outer bulb and superficial cut injury on right hind cannon.

PERFECT HALO (K.G. Likith Appu) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

BARONESS (Angad) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Compulsory urine and blood sample were taken for analysis at the request of the owner (Mr. Pradeep Singh) from b m PORT OF BEAUTY.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g GOLDEN TIME.

2nd Race: 121. The Aboline Plate - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45 (8 Runners).

ARMORY (Rajesh Kumar M) after jumping out threw its head up in the air, did not raise a fluent gallop for the first 100 Metres and ran detached thereafter. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Narayana Gowda V. was informed not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

It was observed that AGUILA (P. Trevor) accidentally stumbled passing the 850 Metres.

Jockey Nazerul Alam, the rider of CHIRAAG was fined Rs.1,000/- for shifting out and causing interference to PERIDOT (Akshay Kumar) on his outside approaching 600 Metres.

It was reported after the race that CHIRAAG (Nazerul Alam) burst its blood vessels. Trainer Mr.Dheeraj.V was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f AGUILA.

3rd Race: 122. The S. G. Madhukar Memorial Trophy - (About) 1200 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only (Horses who have run at least thrice but not placed second, third or fourth even once ineligible) (Outstation horses eligible) (10 Runners).

Jockey Arul J.H, the rider of STARS ABOVE was questioned in presence of trainer Mr. Arjun Mangalorkar. The trainer stated that he had asked the Jockey to take a good jump, maintain a good position and do his best in the straight but after jumping out the horse was keen and the rider allowed the horse to drop its position and further added that he also dropped his hands in the final stages of the race. The Jockey stated that he tried to be up with the field but he could not do so and after that his mount was hanging out after entering the straight. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, the stipes gave the benefit of doubt to the rider and concerned. He was informed that a similar manner of riding would entail him being reported to the stewards for appropriate action.

Jockey M. Mark, the rider of ENGLISH BAY was fined Rs.3,000/- for the excessive use of the whip on his mount during the race (1st infringement).

ENGLISH BAY (M. Mark) sustained superficial gum injury.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f QUEENSTOWN.

4th Race: 123. The Abode of Clouds Trophy - (About) 1100 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only (Horses who have run at least thrice but not placed second, third or fourth even once ineligible) (Outstation horses eligible) (10 Runners).

Jockey P. S. Chouhan, the rider of TRIPITAKA was fined Rs.1,000/- for coming 'in' and causing interference to the horses on his inside viz; RANDOLPH (Hindu Singh), which in turn passed it onto GOLDEN STARLET (Rajesh Kumar M) at the start.

It was observed that THE PIRATE (A.R.Pradeep) was inclined to run out between the 900 Metres to 600 Metres.

Jockey Vishal N Bunde, the rider of SAGACIOUS reported that he could not get a clear run in the final 50 Metres.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b c FORTY NINER.

5th Race: 124. The Karnataka Police Trophy - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 40 to 65, 4 years old and over (8 Runners).

IN A BREEZE (K.G. Likith Appu) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Irfan Ghatala was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

CAPABLE (Siddaraju.P) jumped awkwardly outwards.

Jockey K.G. Likith Appu, the rider of IN A BREEZE was fined Rs.1,000/- for coming 'in' and causing interference to ALMANACH (Surya P.) on his inside approaching 350 Metres.

Jockey Vinod Shinde, the rider of PEYO was fined Rs.5,000/- for the excessive use of whip on his mount during the race (2nd infringement).

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g PEYO.

6th Race: 125. The Marilingaiah Memorial Trophy - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 40 to 65 (12 Runners).

CAESARS PALACE (Nazerul Alam) planted, lost many lengths, did not raise a fluent gallop and ran detached thereafter. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. M. Rajendra Singh was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

Jockey S. John, the rider of GENERAL PATTON reported that his mount brushed the left side of the starting gates while jumping out.

It was reported after the race that CHUL BUL RANI (Surya P.) pulled up lame on left fore and sustained deep cut injury on left fore cannon. Trainer Mr.Dheeraj.V was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

AZTEC QUEEN (Akshay Kumar) sustained superficial injury on right stifle.

An enquiry was held on 24/7/2022 into the interference caused by Jockey Surya P., the rider of CHUL BUL RANI in the above race. In that "he rode in a negligent manner and did not exercise sufficient control over his mount, whereby his mount hit the rails and he shifted out and causing interference to MICHIGAN MELODY (Y. S. Srinath), who in turn passed it onto IMPERIAL POWER (Suraj Narredu) passing the 900 Metres. SONATA (Hindu Singh) who was travelling directly behind also had to be checked by its rider and shift out to avoid striking the front runner CHUL BUL RANI (Surya. P). Further as a result the horses which were running behind viz; KAY STAR (P. Trevor) and GENERAL PATTON (S. John) also had to steady their respective mounts.

Jockey Surya P was interviewed by the Stipendiary Steward. The Stipendiary Steward after considering the submissions made by Jockey Surya P and after

viewing the CCTV decided to charge Jockey Surya P for riding in a negligent manner.

The Stipendiary Steward thereafter suspended the Jockey's Licence granted to Surya P on **4th August, 2022** as he had pleaded guilty of the charge under Rule No. 161 (i) of the BTC Rules of Racing for Negligent Riding on his mount CHUL BUL RANI (he was permitted to ride work) and was informed of his right to appeal.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b c IMPERIAL POWER.

7th Race: 126. The Tudor Jet Plate - (About) 1600 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 4 years old and over (10 Runners).

NOBLE RULER (Vishal N Bunde) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.S. Ganapathy was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

It was reported after the race that SHAN E AZEEM (Vivek.G) burst its blood vessels. Trainer Mr.Sriram Komandur was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch f SPECTACULAR.

8th Race: 127. The Sha Tin Plate - Div. I - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 00 to 25, to be ridden by Indian Jockeys Claiming allowance (Whips not allowed) (12 Runners).

Jockey K.G. Likith Appu, the rider of SPEED SEVEN was reprimanded for travelling wide rounding the final bend for no apparent reason.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b g SUPER KIND.
