# BANGALORE SUMMER MEETING 2023 SEVENTH DAY, SATURDAY, 10<sup>TH</sup> JUNE, 2023 RACING INCIDENTS

(44 - 50)

**GOING: Good** 

PENETROMETER READING: 3.3 Cms.

RAILING POSITION: Railing fixed at average width of 9.0 Meters from 1600 Meters to winning post from its original position.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Race: 44. The Rare Gem Plate - Div. III - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 4 years old and over (8 Runners).

CHIRAAG (Siddaraju.P) planted and lost many lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.M. Rajendra Singh was informed not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

Jockey Angad, the rider of QUEVEGA was fined Rs.2,000/- for not improving his position between the 1000 Metres till about 600 Metres.

Jockey Salman Khan, the rider of BURST OF BLAZE reported that his mount was hanging 'in' after entering the straight. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. Trainer Mr.Warren Singh was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Jockey Angad, the rider of QUEVEGA was reprimanded for shifting 'in' and inconveniencing BURST OF BLAZE (Salman Khan) on his inside passing the 300 Metres.

It was reported after the race that CHIRAAG (Siddaraju.P) burst its blood vessels. Trainer Mr.M. Rajendra Singh was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

It was reported after the race that MR HUMBLE (Vishal N Bunde) pulled up lame on left fore. Trainer Mr.Prithviraj B. was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

It was reported after the race that MR HUMBLE (Vishal N Bunde) had apparently lost its left hind shoe during the race.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner gr m SILVER SWIFT.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Race: 45. The Ascot Plate - (About) 1400 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only (Horses who have run at least thrice but not placed second, third or fourth even once ineligible) (8 Runners).

EBOTSE (P. S. Chouhan) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b f TEHANI.

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Race: 46. The Rare Gem Plate - Div. II - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 4 years old and over (8 Runners).

GOLDEN STARLET (Angad) after jumping out did not raise a fluent gallop for the first 100 Metres and ran detached thereafter. In view of its continuous behaviour, Trainer Mr.Narayana Gowda V. was informed not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least two Mock Races.

GLOW IN THE DARK (A.Ashhad Asbar) was slowly away and lost many lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Warren Singh was informed not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

Jockey A.Ashhad Asbar, the rider of GLOW IN THE DARK was fined Rs.3,000/- for not sufficiently persevering with his mount in the final 100 Metres.

GLOW IN THE DARK (A.Ashhad Asbar) was subjected to veterinary examination. On examination, it was found to have bit injury below tongue (sublingal).

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g MACRON.

### 4<sup>th</sup> Race: 47. The Manjri Stud Plate - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 40 to 65, 4 years old and over (8 Runners).

TOUGH COOKIE (A.R.Pradeep) was extremely fractious inside the gates and injured its rider. Under the circumstances, it was permitted to be withdrawn before coming under Starter's order.

TRIPITAKA (Siddaraju.P) reared up and sat down inside the starting gates. On immediate examination by the Club's Veterinary Officer, it was found to have sustained bleeding cut injury on left fore arm. Under the circumstances, it was permitted to be withdrawn on veterinary grounds before coming under Starter's order. Trainer Mr.Irfan Ghatala was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch f ETERNAL PRINCESS.

#### 5<sup>th</sup> Race: 48. The Brig.R.C.R. Hill Memorial Trophy - (About) 1800 metres. Horses rated 40 to 65 (7 Runners).

Trainer Mr. S. Sreekanth was fined Rs.1,000/- for failing to produce the declared colors at the scales in respect of his charge TRUTH (S. Saqlain). Subsequently, All Black emergency colors were permitted to be used.

TIGNANELLO (P. S. Chouhan) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Irfan Ghatala was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey Akshay Kumar, the rider of MIGHTY ZO was reprimanded for shifting 'in' and inconveniencing SPLENDIDO (Vinod Shinde) on his inside passing the 300 Metres.

TIGNANELLO (P. S. Chouhan) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b c MIGHTY ZO.

#### 6<sup>th</sup> Race: 49. The Nawab M Arshad Ali Khan Memorial Cup - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 70 and above (10 Runners).

Jockey S. Saqlain, the rider of RAISINA STAR was reprimanded for shifting 'in' and inconveniencing ISNT SHE BEAUTIFUL (P. Trevor) on his inside passing the 1300 Metres.

Jockey N. S. Parmar, the rider of FAST RAIN reported that he could not get a clear run in the final 200 Metres due to a closely packed field.

Jockey S. Saqlain, the rider of RAISINA STAR reported that he could not get a clear run in the final 100 Metres due to a closely packed field.

ISNT SHE BEAUTIFUL (P. Trevor) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Trainer Mr. Imtiaz Khan and Jockey P. Trevor were questioned regarding the running and riding of ISNT SHE BEAUTIFUL in the above race.

The trainer stated that:

- a) He had instructed the Jockey to ride his own race and do his best;
- b) He did not take any exception to the positioning of Jockey P. Trevor as his charge was running over 1400 Metres for the first time;
- c) His charge did not relish the extra two hundred metres as his charge stopped galloping in the final 100 Metres;
- d) He would run his charge in 1200 Metres during the season.

The Jockey while corroborating the statements of the trainer added that 1400 Metres was little too much for his mount. However, he added that his mount had pulled up sound after the race.

Their explanations were noted for future reference.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from b f ISNT SHE BEAUTIFUL.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b c MONTEVERDI.

#### 7<sup>th</sup> Race: 50. The Rare Gem Plate - Div. I - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 4 years old and over (8 Runners).

STAR ADMIRAL (Bhawani Singh) after jumping out swerved towards the left, did not raise a fluent gallop and ran detached thereafter. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Aravind G. was informed not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b q PAVAROTTI.

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Permission was granted to trainer Mr. Neil Darashah to deputize on behalf of trainer Mr. Imtiaz A. Sait who was unable to attend the races.
