BANGALORE SUMMER MEETING 2023 ELEVENTH DAY, SATURDAY, 24TH JUNE, 2023 RACING INCIDENTS

<u>(73 - 79)</u>

GOING: Good

PENETROMETER READING: 4.0 Cms.

RAILING POSITION: Railing fixed at average width of 2.0 Meters from

1600 Meters to winning post from its original position.

1st Race: 73. The Dupont Plate - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 4 years old and over (Whips not allowed) (12 Runners).

THE PIRATE (Arul J.H) jumped awkwardly outwards onto TWILIGHT TORNADO (Inayat) soon after the start.

Jockey Vinod Shinde, the rider of APPSARA was reprimanded for travelling wide between the 1200 Metres till about 700 Metres for no apparent reason.

It was observed that QUEVEGA (Rajesh Kumar M) accidentally stumbled passing the 1000 Metres.

WHITE ROSES (P. Trevor) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b q TWILIGHT TORNADO.

2nd Race: 74. The Sir Bruce Plate - Div. II - (About) 1400 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only (Horses who have run at least thrice but not placed second, third or fourth even once ineligible) (9 Runners).

TIME LIMIT (Khurshad Alam) after jumping out did not raise a fluent gallop and was inclined to run out from 900 Metres despite the best efforts of the Jockey, thereafter the horse went onto the sand track approaching 800 Metres. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. S. Dominic was informed not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

Jockey Antony Raj S., the rider of NORWEGIAN WOOD was fined Rs.1,000/- for coming 'in' and taking the ground of AMAZING ATTRACTION (P. Trevor) passing the 1300 Metres.

Jockey S. Saqlain, the rider of ANADALE reported that his mount was hanging out from 800 Metres. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr.Irfan Ghatala was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Jockey K. Sai Kiran, the rider of THE WELCOME reported that his mount was hanging out after entering the straight and ran detached thereafter. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Sharat Kumar was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again and also ensure better performance of his charge in future.

Jockey Antony Raj S., the rider of NORWEGIAN WOOD reported that his mount was running green after entering the straight.

Jockey Antony Raj S., the rider of NORWEGIAN WOOD reported that he did not get a clear run in the final 50 Metres due to a closely packed field.

TIME LIMIT (Khurshad Alam) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f AMAZING ATTRACTION.

3rd Race: 75. The Prabalo Plate - Div. II - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over (9 Runners).

SACRED CREATOR (Rajesh Kumar M) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Narayana Gowda V. was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

SPIRIT DANCER (Y. S. Srinath) jumped awkwardly outwards onto CAPRI GIRL (K. Sai Kiran) soon after the straight.

Jockey Antony Raj S., the rider of DOMINA reported that his mount was hanging out from the 800 Metres. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Arjun Mangalorkar was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Jockey Y. S. Srinath, the rider of SPIRIT DANCER reported that his mount was hanging out after entering the straight. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. S. Ganapathy was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Jockey Vinod Shinde, the rider of STRIKING POINT reported that his mount was not galloping fluently in the final 400 Metres. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b m CAPRI GIRL.

4th Race: 76. The Sir Bruce Plate - Div. I - (About) 1400 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only (Horses who have run at least thrice but not placed second, third or fourth even once ineligible) (8 Runners).

POWERFULL PRINCESS (Khurshad Alam) ran detached from the field. Trainer Mr. S. Dominic was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

Jockey Afroz Khan, the rider of WINDSOR reported that he accidently lost his whip approaching 300 Meters.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g GOLDEN GLOW.

5th Race: 77. The D. Kumar Siddanna Memorial Cup - (About) 2000 metres. Horses rated 40 to 65 (5 Runners).

It was reported after the race that FORTUNATE SON (N. S. Parmar) pulled up lame on right fore. Trainer Mr. M. K. Jadhav was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b c CHAMPIONS WAY.

6th Race: 78. The Chief Justice's Cup (Grade III) - (About) 1800 metres. 4 years old and over. (6 Runners).

Jockey Akshay Kumar, the rider of THIRD AVENUE reported that his mount was hanging 'in' despite his best efforts, in the process he shifted 'in' and inconvenienced KING'S RANSOM (P. S. Chouhan) on his inside in the final 100 Metres.

The Stipendiary Stewards reported Jockey P. S. Chouhan, the rider of KING'S RANSOM to the Stewards for Dangerous Riding [Rule No. 161 (i) of the B.T.C. Rules of Racing] in the above race. In that he shifted 'in' sharply under the use of whip, thereby causing severe interference to MOJITO (A. Imran Khan), which in turn passed it onto JAKE (Antony Raj.S) on his inside in the final 200 Metres. Thus, riding in a Dangerous Manner. The Stewards held an enquiry after the last race and

examined the Jockeys concerned P. S. Chouhan (KING'S RANSOM), A.Imran Khan (MOJITO) and Antony Raj. S (JAKE), they viewed the CCTV replay of the race in question from various angles. After deliberations, they decided to suspend the Jockey's licence granted to P. S. Chouhan from 4th July, 2023 to 16th July, 2023 (Both days inclusive) and fine him a sum of Rs.25,000/- for Dangerous Riding [Rule No. 161 (i) of the B.T.C. Rules of Racing] on his mount KING'S RANSOM in the above race (he is permitted to ride work) and he was informed of his right to appeal.

KING'S RANSOM (P. S. Chouhan) was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Compulsory urine and blood samples were taken for analysis from the following I,II & III placed horses viz:

b c THIRD AVENUE I b g RASPUTIN II b f KING'S RANSOM III

7th Race: 79. The Prabalo Plate - Div. I - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over (9 Runners).

It was observed that the saddle on SILVER SWIFT (C.Umesh) had shifted towards the left, whereby the rider was totally unbalanced and dislodged approaching 1100 Metres and thereafter the horse ran rider less. On immediate examination of the saddle after the race, it was found to be under the belly on the horse. Hence, Trainer Mr. Azhar Ali was fined Rs.10,000/- for his negligence in discharge of his duties as a trainer.

THE OMEGA MAN (Tousif Khan) was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from b g THE OMEGA MAN.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch m CLASSIC CHARM.

Permission was granted to trainers M/s. M. Rajendra Singh and Vijay Singh to deputize on behalf of trainers M/s. S. Sreekanth and Bharath Singh who was unable to attend the races.
