BANGALORE SUMMER MEETING 2024 SECOND DAY, SUNDAY, 14th JULY 2024 RACING INCIDENTS (10-18)

GOING : Good

PENETROMETER READING: 4.0 Cms.

RAILING POSITION: Railing fixed at average width of 6.0 Meters from 1600 Meters to winning post from its original position.

1st Race: 10. The Track Lightning Stakes - Div. II - (About) 1400 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only (Horses who have run at least thrice but not placed second, third or fourth even once ineligible) (7 Runners).

Permission was granted to Trainer Mr. James Mckeown to withdraw ZEBULA on veterinary grounds as it was found to have tendinitis on right fore. He was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

VICTOR HUGO (Vivek.G) walked out of the gates.

IRON KING (P. Trevor) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g RANQUELINO.

2nd Race: 11. The Sweet Memories Stakes - Div. II - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over (9 Runners).

ULTIMATE CHANCE (Tousif Khan) planted and lost many lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.S. Dominic was informed not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

An enquiry was held by the Stipendiary Steward into the interference caused by Jockey Angad, the rider of LAUTERBRUNNEN in the above race. In that he shifted 'in' sharply and caused severe interference to EMBOSOM (Shreyas Singh S) and SPIRIT DANCER (Vishal N Bunde) along the rails passing the 950 Metres and for further slowing down the pace approaching 900 Metres, whereby EMBOSOM (Shreyas Singh S) and SPIRIT DANCER (Vishal N Bunde) had to be checked by their respective riders.

Jockey Angad was interviewed by the Stipendiary Steward. The Stipendiary Steward after considering the submissions made by Jockey Angad and after viewing the CCTV replay decided to charge Jockey Angad for Careless Riding.

The Stipendiary Steward thereafter suspended the Jockey's Licence granted to Angad for *four (4) race days of Bangalore Summer Meeting 2024 i.e., 26/7/2024, 27/7/2024, 2/8/2024 & 3/8/2024* as had he pleaded guilty to the charge under Rule No. 161 (i) of the BTC Rules of Racing for Careless Riding on his mount LAUTERBRUNNEN (he was permitted to ride work) and was informed of his right to appeal.

SUPER KIND (A. Sandesh) was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from dk b g SUPER KIND.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g THE ATHABASCA.

<u>3rd Race: 12. The Epsom Stakes - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated</u> <u>40 to 65 (11 Runners).</u>

DISRUPTOR (Darshan R.N) on the way to weighing scale sustained bleeding cut injury on right hind pastern and superficial injury on both knees. Under the circumstances, it was permitted to be withdrawn on veterinary grounds. Trainer Mr. Imtiaz Khan was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

KLIMT (D. Patel) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Imtiaz Khan was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

An enquiry was held by the Stipendiary Steward into the interference caused by Jockey Salman Khan, the rider of MILLBROOK in the above race. In that he shifted 'in' and caused interference to GOLD RIDE (S.J. Moulin), which in turn passed it onto GOLDEN PEAKS (A. Sandesh) and BHARAT (D'nuSingh Deora) approaching 1300 Metres and for his carelessness in not wearing the goggles during the race.

Jockey Salman Khan was interviewed by the Stipendiary Steward. The Stipendiary Steward after considering the submissions made by Jockey Salman Khan and after viewing the CCTV replay decided to charge Jockey Salman Khan for Careless Riding.

The Stipendiary Steward thereafter suspended the Jockey's Licence granted to Salman Khan **for four (4) race days of Bangalore Summer Meeting 2024 i.e., 26/7/2024, 27/7/2024, 2/8/2024 & 3/8/2024,** as had he pleaded guilty to the charge under Rule No. 161 (i) of the BTC Rules of Racing for Careless Riding on his mount MILLBROOK (he was permitted to ride work) and was informed of his right to appeal.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner gr g GALAHAD.

4th Race: 13. The Sweet Memories Stakes - Div. I - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over (9 Runners).

Jockey Ram Nandan Manjhi, the rider of OSIRIS reported that he accidentally lost his whip on his mount approaching 150 Meters.

It was reported after the race that REMONTOIR (Arshad Alam) burst its blood vessels. Trainer Mr. Imtiaz Khan was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

It was reported after the race that CHISOX (Arvind Kumar. N) burst its blood vessels and sustained cut injury on right fore fetlock. Trainer Mr.Pradeep Annaiah was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

STAR ADMIRAL (Vishal N Bunde) sustained cut injury on left hind fetlock.

An enquiry is being held into the running and riding of OXYTOCIN, trained by Mr.Warren Singh and ridden by Jockey K. Sai Kiran in the above race.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g OSIRIS.

5th Race: 14. The Manitou Stakes - Div. II - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45 (8 Runners).

Jockey S.J. Moulin, the rider of INVINCIBLE reported that his mount was inclined to run out from the 800 Metres. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Darius R. Byramji was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Jockey S. Hussain, the rider of TIGERKING was fined Rs.3,000/- for coming 'in' and causing interference to INVINCIBLE (S.J. Moulin) on his inside approaching 1000 Metres.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b c JERSEY KING.

<u>6th Race: 15. The Mayor's Trophy - (About) 1400 metres. Horses</u> rated 60 to 85 (10 Runners).

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b c SANTISSIMO.

7th Race: 16. The Be Safe Cup - (About) 1200 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only (Horses who have run at least thrice but not placed second, third or fourth even once ineligible) (11 Runners).

Jockey Tousif Khan, the rider of SUPER BOLD was fined Rs.1,000/- for shifting out and causing interference to the horses viz; HELIOS (S.J. Moulin), TOTALLY EPIC (Siddaraju.P) and RODNEY (B. R. Kumar) on his outside at the start.

Jockey Suraj Narredu, the rider of BOURBONAIRE was severely reprimanded for easing his mount during the final stages of the race.

It was reported after the race that SILVER STRIKE (Vishal N Bunde) pulled up lame on right fore. Trainer Mr.Prithviraj B. was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

SUPER BOLD (Tousif Khan) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g BOURBONAIRE.

8th Race: 17. The Track Lightning Stakes - Div. I - (About) 1400 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only (Horses who have run at least thrice but not placed second, third or fourth even once ineligible) (8 Runners).

STORM SHADOW (Suraj Narredu) jumped awkwardly outwards onto AHEAD OF THE CURVE (Salman Khan) and SANTORIUS (S.J. Moulin) on its outside soon after the start.

Jockey Antony Raj S., the rider of WESTLAKE reported that his mount was drifted out under pressure in the final 100 Metres, whereby he inconvenienced AHEAD OF THE CURVE (Salman Khan).

Jockey Suraj Narredu, the rider of STORM SHADOW reported that momentarily he had to steady his mount approaching 150 Metres due to a closely packed field.

WESTLAKE (Antony Raj S.) sustained injury on right nasal bridge.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b c MANSA MUSA.

<u>9th Race: 18. The Manitou Stakes - Div. I - (About) 1200 metres.</u> <u>Horses rated 20 to 45 (8 Runners).</u>

PRINCESS GOLD (P. Sai Kumar) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

SOUTHERNARISTOCRAT (B. L. Paswan) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g NEVER GIVE IN.
