GOING: Good

PENETROMETER READING: 3.4 Cms.

RAILING POSITION: Railing fixed at average width of 8.0 Meters from 1600 Meters to winning post from its original position.

1st Race: 32. The Classical Act Plate - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 00 to 25, 6 years old and over (8 Runners).

NOBLE RULER (Koshi Kumar) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. S. Ganapathy was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

It was observed that GOLDEN GALLERY (Vivek.G) stopped galloping in the final 150 Metres and the rider having to dismount before passing the winning post. On immediate examination by the Club's Veterinary Officer it was found to have burst its blood vessels. Trainer Mr. V. Lokanath was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch g DEBONAIR.

2nd Race: 33. The Romantic Dance Stakes - (About) 1600 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45 (9 Runners).

ISABELLE (L. Alex Rozario) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Irfan Ghatala was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey S. Hussain, the rider of SEA JACK was fined Rs.2,000/- for coming 'in' and tightening SASSY (Akshay Kumar) on his inside passing the 1400 Metres.

Jockey Antony Raj S., the rider of AUGUST was reprimanded for shifting 'in' and inconveniencing PHARAZON (Suraj Narredu) on his inside passing the 800 Metres.

Jockey Arshad Alam, the rider of TURKOMAN was reprimanded for riding an indifferent race.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner gr f REGAL ARISTOCRACY.

3rd Race: 34. The Chettinad Stud Plate - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 40 to 65, 5 years old and over (11 Runners).

SEKHMET (S. Hussain) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Kishan Thomas was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

HIGH OPINION (Akshay Kumar) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Kishan Thomas. K was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey S.K.Paswan, the rider of EXTRAORDINARY was fined Rs.2,000/- for not wearing the goggles during the race.

(A)

An enquiry was held by the Stipendiary Steward into the manner of riding by Jockey S. Hussain, the rider of SEKHMET in the above race. In that he did not exercise sufficient control on his mount soon after jumping out of the starting gates, especially under the use of whip, wherein he allowed his mount to collided with the false rails before passing the red marker post.

Jockey S. Hussain was interviewed by the Stipendiary Steward. The Stipendiary Steward after considering the submissions made by Jockey S. Hussain and after viewing the CCTV replay decided to charge Jockey S. Hussain for Incompetent Riding.

The Stipendiary Steward thereafter suspended the Jockey's Licence granted to S. Hussain for *two (2) race days of Bangalore Summer Meeting 2024 i.e.*, 8/8/2024 & 9/8/2024 as he had pleaded guilty to the charge under Rule No. 161 (ii) of the BTC Rules of Racing for Incompetent Riding on his mount SEKHMET (he was permitted to ride work) and was informed of his right to appeal.

(B)

An enquiry was held by the Stipendiary Steward into the interference caused by Jockey Rayan Ahmed. R, the rider of OWN LEGACY in the above race. In that he did not exercise sufficient control on his mount, whereby he shifted 'in' and tightened AHERNE (A. Sandesh) who had to steady his mount and shift 'in', causing severe interference to ARDAKAN (Arvind Kumar. N) totally unbalancing Jockey Arvind Kumar. N (ARDAKAN) along the rails approaching 1000 Metres.

Jockey Rayan Ahmed. R was interviewed by the Stipendiary Steward. The Stipendiary Steward after considering the submissions made by Jockey Rayan Ahmed. R and after viewing the CCTV replay decided to charge Jockey Rayan Ahmed. R for Careless Riding.

The Stipendiary Steward thereafter suspended the Jockey's Licence granted to Rayan Ahmed. R for **two** (2) race days of Bangalore Summer Meeting 2024 i.e., 8/8/2024 & 9/8/2024 as he had pleaded guilty to the charge under Rule No. 161 (i) of the BTC Rules of Racing for Careless Riding on his mount OWN LEGACY (he was permitted to ride work) and was informed of his right to appeal.

OWN LEGACY (Rayan Ahmed R.) was subjected to veterinary examination. on examination it was found to have bit sore on left oral commissure.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b m KALLU SAKKARE.

4th Race: 35. The Speaker's Cup - (About) 1100 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only (Horses who have run at least thrice but not placed second, third or fourth even once ineligible) (11 Runners).

DAYS DATE (L. Alex Rozario) jumped awkwardly onwards onto TOTALLY EPIC (Vinod Shinde), which in turn passed it onto JOYFUL SPIRIT (Faizan Khan) soon after the start.

MARTHA (Vivek.G) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f FINLEY.

5th Race: 36. The Krishnaraja Wadiyar Trophy - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 80 and above (6 Runners).

An enquiry was held by the Stipendiary Steward into the interference caused by Jockey Hemant Chandragiri, the rider of POLISHED GIRL in the above race. In that he did not exercise sufficient control on his mount and allowed his mount to strike the front runner CHAMPIONS WAY (Suraj Narredu) approaching 850 Metres totally unbalancing the CHAMPIONS WAY (Suraj Narredu), thereby CHAMPIONS WAY sustained bleeding clip injury on right hock.

Jockey Hemant Chandragiri was interviewed by the Stipendiary Steward. The Stipendiary Steward after considering the submissions made by Jockey Hemant Chandragiri and after viewing the CCTV replay decided to charge Jockey Hemant Chandragiri for Careless Riding.

The Stipendiary Steward thereafter suspended the Jockey's Licence granted to Hemant Chandragiri for **two** (2) race days of Bangalore Summer Meeting 2024 i.e., 8/8/2024 & 9/8/2024 as he had pleaded guilty to the charge under Rule No. 161 (i) of the BTC Rules of Racing for Careless Riding on his mount POLISHED GIRL (he was permitted to ride work) and was informed of his right to appeal.

CHAMPIONS WAY (Suraj Narredu) sustained bleeding clip injury on right hock.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g ALDGATE.

6th Race: 37. The Prince Khartoum Plate - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 4 years old and over (8 Runners).

ANZAC PIPERNAL (Siddaraju.P) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.S. Dominic was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

ANADALE (L. Alex Rozario) stumbled passing the 450 Metres.

SOUTHERNARISTOCRAT (B. L. Paswan) ran detached from the field. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Azhar Ali was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

MEASURE OF TIME (Rayan Ahmed R.) sustained cut injury on right hind tendon.

INVINCIBLE (S.J. Moulin) sustained cut injury on left hind pastern.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b f ANADALE.

Permission was granted to trainer Mr. Kishan Thomas to deputize on behalf of trainer Mr. Prasanna Kumar who was unable to attend the races.
