RACING INCIDENTS
(116– 123)

GOING : Good

PENETROMETER READING : 4.3 Cms.

RAILING POSITION: Railing fixed at an average width of 3 Meters from 1600 Meters to winning post from its original position.

1st Race: 116. The Squanderer Cup - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 00 to 25 (8 Runners).

VERRAZZANO (Suraj Narredu) was squeezed between HONEYPOT (Angad) and SOUTHERNARISTOCRAT (C.Umesh) at the start.

Jockey Angad, the rider of HONEYPOT was fined Rs.3,000/- for repeatedly checking his mount from the start till about 700 Metres for no apparent reason.

Jockey Rajesh Kumar M, the rider of MARTHA reported that his mount was not striding out well during the race as such he had to stop riding in the final 150 Metres. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Jockey Suraj Narredu, the rider of VERRAZZANO reported that his mount was hanging 'in' after entering the straight. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. S. Narredu was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Jockey Shivam, the rider of ICE STORM reported that he accidentally lost his whip passing the 400 Meters.

Jockey Darshan R.N, the rider of ROYAL WHISPER was fined Rs.3,000/- for the excessive use of the whip on his mount during the race (1st infringement).

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b f CASCAIS.

2nd Race: 117. The Kolkata Cup - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 40 to 65, 5 years old and over (8 Runners).

GIMMLER (Vivek.G) took a fly jump and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Rutherford Alford was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey Shivam, the rider of DUFY was fined Rs.3,000/- for repeatedly checking his mount between the 1300 Metres till about 1000 Metres for no apparent reason.

Jockey Shivam, the rider of DUFY was severely reprimanded for dropping hands in the final 150 Metres.

Jockey Akshay Kumar, the rider of AQUAMATIC was fined Rs.3,000/- for the excessive use of the whip on his mount during the race (1st infringement).

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g STRAVINSKY.

3rd Race: 118. The Delhi Cup - (About) 1600 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45 (11 Runners).

FINAL CALL (Neeraj Rawal) reared up as the gates opened and lost few lengths. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. S. Padmanabhan was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey Koshi Kumar, the rider of LEGENDARY IMPACT reported that his mount shied outwards while making his run passing 450 Metres, whereby the Jockey was totally unbalanced & was unseated from his mount and the horse ran rider less thereafter. As the incident was accidental no action was taken beyond noting the incident.

Jockey Suraj Narredu, the rider of MULTI SUCCESS reported that his mount did not find its footings from 1000 Metres to 700 Metres and totally stopped galloping in the final 100 Metres. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from b c MAHLER.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f N R I VICTORY.

4th Race: 119. The Mysore Cup - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45 (9 Runners).

THE COMMANDER (Tousif Khan) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.S. Dominic was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

HYPERDRIVE (Pavan) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f STAR OF INDIA.

5th Race: 120. The Hooves of Steel Million - Div. I - (About) 1400 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only (Horses who have run at least thrice but not placed second, third or fourth even once ineligible) (8 Runners).

TURF PARADISE (Suraj Narredu) took a fly jump.

Jockey C.A.Brisson, the rider of SILVER QUEST had to steady his mount passing the 800 Metres due to a closely packed field.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from gr f SILVER QUEST.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f MAANA.

6th Race: 121. The Coromandel Gromor Bangalore Million - (About) 1400 metres. 3-year-old horses(foaled in 2022). (8 Runners).

Jockey A. Sandesh, the rider of SICYON reported that his mount slipped from its hind passing the 700 Metres. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

An enquiry is being held into the running and riding of BIG BAY, trained by Mr. M. Narredu and ridden by Jockey Yash Narredu in the above race.

BIG BAY (Yash Narredu) was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from b g BIG BAY.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f ICE OF FIRE.

7th Race: 122. The Chennai Cup - (About) 1600 metres. Horses rated 60 to 85 (8 Runners).

Jockey Rajesh Kumar M, the rider of INVINCIBLE was reprimanded for taking an unduly long lead till about 600 Metres.

Jockey Girish R., the rider of ALL ATTRACTION was reprimanded for travelling wide rounding the final bend for no apparent reason.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f EMPHATIC.

8th Race: 123. The Hooves of Steel Million - Div. II - (About) 1400 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only (Horses who have run at least thrice but not placed second, third or fourth even once ineligible) (7 Runners).

Permission was granted to Trainer Mr.Irfan Ghatala to withdraw ZORAWAR on veterinary grounds as it was found to be lame on right hind and injury on right hind fetlock. He was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Jockey C.Umesh, the rider of LUKE THE NUKE reported that he accidentally lost his whip approaching 300 Meters.

LUKE THE NUKE (C.Umesh) was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from b c LUKE THE NUKE.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b f NEPTUNE.
