NOTICE

1. It is hereby notified for the information of all concerned that with a view to controlling and eradicating the Equine Infectious Anaemia, the Managing Committee of Bangalore Turf Club Ltd., has decided that all horses coming to this centre to be stabled or raced during Bangalore Winter Meeting 2007-2008, must have a valid Coggins Test Certificate negative for E.I.A. Owners and Trainers intending to stable or race their horses at this centre will be required to produce a Certificate to this effect.
 2. No horse will be permitted to race during Bangalore Winter Meeting 2007-2008 unless stabled in B.T.C. premises with the prior permission of the Management. However, Mysore based horses will be eligible to participate in races for horses rated 80 and above.
 3. (a) In respect of Bangalore based horses registered on or before 30.11.2007 stables will be provided :
 - i) for 3, 4 and 5 years old rated 00 and above
 - ii) for 6 and 7 years old rated 80 and above. However, 6 and 7 years old rated 80 to 90 will not be eligible to participate in races for horses rated 60 to 90.
 - iii) for 2-year-olds (Foaled in 2005) under the charge of 'A' Licence Trainers which are stabled in the B.T.C. premises as on 31.10.2007.
 - (b) Horses which cross the specified age limit on 1.1.2008 will be permitted to be stabled in B.T.C. premises till the conclusion of Bangalore Winter Meeting 2007-2008.
 - (c) In case a horse fails to run at least TWICE or does not earn stakes for any place even ONCE under B.T.C. rules during the period 1.11.2007 to 31.10.2008, service charges as detailed below will be debited to the account of the Owner/s concerned :

If the horse does not run even once	:	Rs. 5,000/-
If the horse runs only once	:	Rs. 2,000/-
- However, horses certified unfit for racing by the Club's Veterinary Officer during the above period will be exempt from service charges.
4. (a) Outstation horses under the charge of 'A' licence trainers who were allotted stables for participating in Bangalore Summer

Meeting 2007 and who are stabled in the B.T.C. premises alone will be entitled for allotment of stables in the following order of priority, subject to availability of stables :-

- (i) All 3 years old that are entered for Bangalore Winter Classic/s 2007-2008 and not struck out till the date of stable allotment.
 - (ii) All 3 years old that are entered for at least three Sweepstakes races to be run during Bangalore Winter Meeting 2007-2008.
 - (iii) 3 and 4 years old rated 60 and above.
 - (iv) 5 and 6 years old rated 80 and above.
 - (v) 7 years old rated 100 and above.
- (b) 2 years old and horses rated below 60 {excepting those eligible under clauses (a) (i) & (ii) above} will not be entitled for allotment of stables.
 - (c) Horses which cross the specified age limit on 1.1.2008 will be permitted to be stabled in B.T.C. premises till the conclusion of Bangalore Winter Meeting 2007-2008.
 - (d) Every application for allotment of stables shall be accompanied by a deposit towards service charge @ Rs.. 10,000/- per stable. The deposit shall be paid by a crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of Bangalore Turf Club Ltd., payable at Bangalore. In case of stable/s not being allotted in respect of any horse/s the deposit paid will be refunded.
 - (e) Application not accompanied by the requisite Demand Draft is liable to be rejected. Application for stable accommodation should be submitted on or before 31st October, 2007.
 - (f) In case a horse fails to run TWICE during Bangalore Winter Meeting 2007-2008, service charges as detailed below will be debited to the account of the Owner/s concerned :-
If the horse does not race at all Rs. 25,000/-
If the horse runs only once Rs. 12,500/-
5. No owner will be permitted to stable more than 100 Bangalore based horses of any age, either wholly or partly owned by him. This ceiling will include a maximum of 40 two-year-olds.
 6. Number of horses under the charge of 'A' Licence Trainers permitted to be stabled in B.T.C. premises shall not exceed 1000 including 2-year-olds.

7. Stables allotted to a particular Owner/Trainer must be occupied only by horses in his charge. Stables applied for and not occupied before the commencement of Bangalore Winter Meeting 2007-2008 will be allotted to other Owners/Trainers without any further notice. No Owner/Trainer will be permitted to sublet the stables allotted to him.
8. Horses which do not satisfy the condition of eligibility for stabling as specified above will not be permitted to be stabled in the B.T.C. premises under any circumstances.
9. Allotment of stables will be at the entire discretion of the Management which will be final.
10. Horses on arrival should be produced before the Club's Veterinary Officer and a certificate of soundness obtained.
11. No Course Fee or stable rent will be charged in respect of any horse stabled in the B.T.C. premises with the prior approval of the Management.
12. The Club accepts no responsibility for any damage to horses, employees or property whilst in these stables or within the premises.
13. No Entry Fee or Forfeit will be charged in any race except Sweepstakes races. However, service charges will be levied as under :-
 - (a) @ 1% of the stakes to the winner for horses entered as first entries and scratched. (2% in respect of final entries)
 - (b) @ 2% of the stakes to the winner for horses entered as first entries, accepted and withdrawn on any other ground except on Veterinary ground or for fractious behaviour at the starting gates at the time of starting in which case no service charge will be levied. (4% in respect of final entries).

**OATS SUBSIDY TO "A" LICENSED
TRAINERS FOR THE PERIOD
1ST NOVEMBER, 2007 TO 31ST OCTOBER, 2008**

(A) Concessions for 2-year-olds (Foaled in 2006)

1. A sum of Rs. 894 per horse per month will be credited to the account of the Trainer concerned in respect of 2-year-olds (Foaled in 2006) from 1st January 2008 or from the date of arrival in B.T.C. premises whichever is later upto 31st October 2008.
2. If any horse is taken away to any other Centre before 31st December, 2010 without completing four runs under B.T.C. Rules, the entire amount paid as Oats Subsidy by the Club will be recovered from the Trainer/Owner. In addition a service charge will be debited to the Owners' account, for the period for which the horse is stabled in the B.T.C. premises as detailed below :
 - i) if the horse does not run even once : Rs. 1,000/- per month
 - ii) if the horse runs only once : Rs. 750/- per month
 - iii) if the horse runs only twice : Rs. 500/- per month
 - iv) if the horse runs only thrice : Rs. 250/- per monthUntil the amount is recovered the horse will not be permitted to race anywhere.
However, horses certified unfit for racing by the Club's Veterinary Officer will be exempt from service charges, provided such horses leave B.T.C. premises not later than one month from the date of such certification.
3. A maximum of 300 two-year-olds will be permitted to be enrolled as local horses.
4. These 2-year-olds must be registered on or before 30.11.2008.

(B) Concessions for 2/3-year-olds (Foaled in 2005) and 3 years old and over.

1. Oats subsidy will be credited as indicated for 2-year-olds (Foaled in 2006) above provided the horse either runs at least twice under B.T.C. Rules during the period 1st November, 2007 to 31st March, 2008 or earns stakes for any place at least once under B.T.C. Rules during the said period. However, horses certified unfit by the Club's Veterinary Officer will also be paid the above subsidy even if such horses do not complete the requisite number of races during the above period.
In case a horse temporarily leaves the centre, subsidy will be recovered for the period of absence only, if the period extends beyond one month.
2. Only horses which are under the charge of 'A' Licence Trainers and availed of Oats Subsidy before the commencement of Bangalore Winter Meeting 2007-2008 and which are stabled in B.T.C. premises before the commencement of Bangalore Winter Meeting 2007-2008 and are not more than 6 years of age are eligible for subsidised Oats.
3. The number of horses which will receive Oats Subsidy will be limited at the discretion of the Management to a maximum of 1000 horses at any time during the year.

PERFORMANCE LINKED INCENTIVES TO OWNERS OF BANGALORE BASED HORSES

1. In respect of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th placed horses earning stakes in ordinary races during Bangalore Winter Meeting 2007-2008 the following incentive will be credited to the accounts of the owner/s concerned.

Winner	:	Rs.	18,000
Second	:	Rs.	9,000
Third	:	Rs.	4,500
Fourth	:	Rs.	2,700
Fifth	:	Rs.	1,800
Sixth	:	Rs.	900

2. In respect of horses bred in Karnataka, 20% incentive on 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th stakes earned in ordinary races during Bangalore Winter Meeting 2007-2008 will be credited to the accounts of the owner/s concerned.
3. In respect of local horses, 20% incentive on 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th stakes earned in ordinary races during Bangalore Winter Meeting 2007-2008 will be credited on a pro-rata basis to the concerned Owner/s provided such Owner/s has/have no interest in more than five local horses including 2-year-olds (Foaled in 2005) owned either individually and/or jointly and/or by a syndicate. The cut off date for determining the eligibility for the above incentive will be 1st October, 2007 after which any owner acquiring interest in more than five horses excluding 2-year-olds in January 2008 (Foaled in 2005) will cease to receive the above incentive from that date.

In the absence of such a declaration, no incentive will be credited to such Trainer.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. All persons taking part in Bangalore Winter Meeting 2007 - 2008 shall be bound by the Rules of Racing of the B.T.C. and Notifications issued from time to time in the B.T.C. Racing Calendar and such regulations as may be laid down by the Stewards of the Meeting.
2. (a) Unless already registered under B.T.C., R.C.T.C., R.W.I.T.C., M.R.C. or H.R.C. Rules, horses must be registered under these rules; otherwise entries will be refused.
(b) Application for allotment of rating of a horse already registered must be made to the Secretary, B.T.C. Ltd. at least two days prior to the dates fixed for closing of entries for the respective race days.
When applying for allotment of rating of a horse under B.T.C. Rules of Racing, the applicant must state the date on which and the centre where the horse last raced. If the horse has never raced before, the age and sex must be stated.
3. (a) No horse shall be entered in any race other than those for which it is eligible unless otherwise mentioned in the conditions of the race.
(b) Horses which have raced at Meetings other than those conducted under the B.T.C. Rules of Racing subsequent to allotment of rating by the B.T.C. Handicapper, must be allotted the rating again by the B.T.C. Handicapper, prior to entry for Handicap races under these Rules. Entries of any horse for a Handicap race for which application for allotment of rating has not been received, may be refused or cancelled.
(c) In the event of a horse having raced at a Meeting other than under the B.T.C. Rules of Racing subsequent to its having been entered for a Handicap race under B.T.C. Rules, the entries of such horse will be void.
(d) In the event of a horse having raced at a Meeting other than under the B.T.C. Rules of Racing subsequent to having been Handicapped under B.T.C. Rules, such horse shall be withdrawn from the race even after having been Handicapped or Accepted.
4. Before a horse is allowed to start in a race for the first time under B.T.C. Rules of Racing, such horse must be produced before the

- Club's veterinary Officer for identification. The responsibility of obtaining a copy of the Certificate of Identity rests with the Owner or Trainer concerned.
5. The dates and times at which Forfeits/Scratchings are advertised to fall due are liable to alteration after the closing of entries, should circumstances arise, which in the opinion of the Stewards, make it desirable. All horses accepting i.e. left in after the time fixed for Final Forfeits/Scratchings must be declared to start unless prior permission for their withdrawal has been obtained from the Stewards. No horse shall be accepted to participate in more than one race on the same day or the following day and when the Handicaps for two days are published on the same day no horse shall be accepted to participate in more than one race during those two days.
In the event of a horse being left in for more than one race in contravention of the above rule the person responsible for it shall be fined not less than Rs. 1,000/-, but the Owner of such horse shall be permitted to run such horse in any one race of his choice.
 6. Owners, Trainers and Jockeys should make themselves familiar with the B.T.C. Track Rules.
 7. (a) Unless accompanied by a remittance for the full amount of entrance fees, entries may be refused. If the entries are not signed by the Owner, they must be accompanied by a written authority from the Owner to the enterer, unless such authority has already been registered by B.T.C.
(b) In the case of entry made by telegram, confirmation in writing and remittance must be sent forthwith. No horse will be permitted to run unless the entry money has been paid.
(c) Entries should be made on official forms and correct details of all particulars required in the forms should be filled in.
 8. (a) The full advertised prize will be given in every race except in the case of a walk-over when only half the advertised prize will be given subject to the deduction as provided in clause (c) below.
(b) The stakes for the fourth, fifth and sixth placed horses in whichever race these are offered will be given provided there are at least eight, nine and ten acceptors respectively in that race. However, this rule will not apply to Sweepstakes races.

- (c) i) One percent of all stakes, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th will be deducted as Owners' Contribution towards the Karnataka Racehorse Owners' Association Fund.
- ii) Four percent of all stakes, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th will be deducted as Owners' contribution to the Owners' Fund.
- iii) Five percent of all stakes, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th will be deducted as Owners' contribution to a separate fund.
- (d) Out of the 10% of all stakes, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th credited to the Trainers' Accounts as their commission, 1% of all stakes will be deducted as Trainers' contribution to the Trainers' Fund.
- (e) The prizes for lower division race/s, if any, will be the same as for the first division except that trophy or value of trophy in a cup race will NOT be given for lower division race/s.
9. (a) The Stewards reserve the right, to declare void any race in which there are less than 12 entries in bona fide separate interests.
- (b) The number of races will be restricted to a maximum of eight on all race days except the days when there is only one race day in the week and on the days when the following races are run where it will be restricted to Maximum of nine races :- 1000 Guineas, 2000 Guineas, Oaks, Derby & Juvenile Million.
- (c) Unless otherwise specified if at the time of Final Forfeits/Scratchings there are less than FIVE acceptors in bona fide separate interests in a race over a distance of 1800 Metres or more, less than SIX acceptors in bona fide separate interests in a race for horses rated 80 and above and less than EIGHT acceptors in any other race, such race or races may be declared void at the option of the Stewards.
10. (a) The Stewards may arrange the entrants for any race into two or more divisions and in Handicaps adjust the weights of any division at their discretion. At the time of Final Forfeits/Scratchings the Stewards may further arrange for a race, or a division thereof to be divided on the basis of the weights published.
- (b) If in any race other than a Sweepstakes race
- (i) if the acceptors exceed 12 but not more than 15, then the acceptors in excess of 12 will be eliminated by drawing lots amongst the horses belonging to Trainer/s and Owner/s

- (i.e. in the same colours) who have accepted the highest number of horses. If the number of horses eliminated are not sufficient, lots will be drawn again amongst the horses belonging to Trainer/s and Owner/s (i.e. in the same colours) who have accepted the next highest number of horses. This process will be continued till the required number of horses are eliminated.
- (ii) if the acceptors exceed 15 but not more than 24 the race will be divided into two divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (iii) if the acceptors exceed 24 but not more than 31, then the acceptors in excess of 24 will be eliminated as per the procedure detailed above and the race will be divided into two divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (iv) if the acceptors exceed 31 but not more than 36 the race will be divided into three divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (v) if the acceptors exceed 36, then the acceptors in excess of 36 will be eliminated as per the procedure detailed above and the race will be divided into three divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- If in a Sweepstakes race the acceptors exceed 21, the additional acceptors will be rejected by eliminating the horses who have won the lowest aggregate winning stakes after 31st March, 2005. In case of a tie or a Sweepstakes race for Maidens, rejection shall be by drawing lots. Only the final forfeit in respect of the horses eliminated from these races will be refunded.
- (c) Service charges will not be levied in respect of the horses eliminated from races other than the Sweepstakes.
- (d) A horse rejected from a race shall not be excluded by rejection when it has been accepted the next time.
- (e) In case a horse is "left in" in a race where additional acceptors are likely to be eliminated the same horse may be "left in" for any other race on the same day or any other day for which the scratchings are at the same time on the same day with a note on the scratching form that it will be effective if the said horse is not eliminated from the other race for which

the additional acceptors are likely to be eliminated. Similarly a horse may be "left in" in a race with a note on the scratching form that it will be effective if the race in question is not divided.

- (f) If any other condition not stipulated in Clause (e) above is attached to the scratching, such condition shall be ignored.
11. The Stewards reserve the right to refuse an entry or to cancel an accepted entry at any stage without assigning a reason.
12. (a) The Stewards reserve the right to amend or to alter the conditions of any race at any time before the Entry closes and to alter the name of any race after the closing of Entries and to increase the advertised Stakes for any race prior to Final Forfeits/Scratchings.
- (b) The Stewards reserve the right to indicate any race/s to be ridden by Indian Jockeys only at the time of the publication of acceptances.
13. In all Handicaps the lowest weight to be carried shall not be less than 47 Kgs. excluding the Allowance which a Jockey may claim, if applicable. However, the Handicaps may be framed down to weights below 47 Kgs.
14. A winner of a race after publication of weights shall carry 7 Kgs. extra.
15. (a) Minimum top weight in a Handicap race will be 60 Kgs. Unless otherwise specified if the highest weight an acceptor has to carry is less than 60 Kgs. it shall be raised to 60 Kgs. and the other weights shall be raised equally.
- (b) Unless otherwise specified, if the highest weight an Acceptor has to carry in a Terms race is less than 55 Kgs. it shall be raised to 55 Kgs. and the other weights shall be raised equally.
16. No horse shall carry more than 3.5 Kgs. overweight in any race, except with the permission of the Stewards if the horse is ridden by a Jockey who is either not entitled to claim an Allowance or cannot claim an Allowance under the Conditions of the race. However, in case a horse is ridden by a Jockey claiming an Allowance it shall not carry, except with the permission of the Stewards, more than 3.5 Kgs. in excess of the weight which it would have carried if the Jockey in question had claimed in full the

Allowance to which he was entitled. Such permission must be obtained before the Starting Declaration box for such race is opened.

17. Except in Handicaps, the correct weight of any horse not struck out must be declared in writing not later than the date and time published for the Final Forfeits/Scratchings. The person responsible and failing to comply with this condition, will be fined at the discretion of the Stewards.
18. Unless otherwise specified, Starting Declarations to be made by the Owner, Trainer or the Authorised Agent, in respect of all horses for all the races must be placed in the boxes set apart for each race, not later than 10 a.m. on the day prior to the race day. The Declaration must be in writing on an official form and must state the name of the race, the name of the horse, weight to be carried, the name of the Jockey, and must be accompanied by the Jockey's fee for a losing mount, if not already paid, and any other fees due. It shall also state if the horse is running shod or unshod; if the former, it shall state the description of shoes, plates or Tips used. Omissions or errors in the Starting Declaration, will render the Owner, Trainer or the Authorised Agent making it, liable to a fine at the discretion of the Stewards.
19. (a) Indian Jockeys below 25 years of age and apprentices shall be entitled to claim the following allowances in any handicap flat race.

- No allowance can be claimed after having ridden 40 winners or attaining the age of 25 years whichever is earlier. Notwithstanding the above, a jockey reaching the specified limit of wins as stated above will still be entitled to the allowance originally declared provided the betting for such a race has already opened.
- (b) No rider shall ride in any race, unless he is wearing a Skull Cap of a pattern approved by the Stewards.
20. Horses will not be allowed to be led down to the start in advance of the remainder of the field except in very exceptional circumstances, which must be explained to the satisfaction of the Stewards in writing, at least one clear day before the date on which the horse is due to start.

21. Colours must be declared with Entries unless already registered under B.T.C. Rules. Where colours are not registered a declaration must be made of the colours to be used at or prior to the time for closing of Forfeits for that day, otherwise a fine may be imposed.
- If there be more than one horse of any one Owner left in, in a race, a different coloured cap must be declared for each horse.
- Every person running a horse in colours other than those registered or declared as above, may be fined.
- In the event of a person being unable to run a horse in colours as declared in the official race card, the Jockey will wear "All Black". A set of these colours may be obtained from the clerk of the Scales.
22. (a) An Owner's pass, which is not transferable, will be issued for the Meeting to those whose horses are entered. Only one Owner's pass will be given to Joint Owners.
- (b) Trainers and Jockeys must obtain their Passes from the Office, without which they will not be permitted to enter the enclosures.
- (c) Rules in connection with the issue of Passes to Riding Boys, Servants, Farriers and Syces, may be obtained from the Office.
- Applications for all Passes should be made during working hours on non-race days.
23. All telegrams must be confirmed by letters and all communications should be addressed to the Secretary, Bangalore Turf Club Ltd. and not to anyone by name.
