Average width of 5 Metres from 1600 Metres to the winning post.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Race: 232. The Ardent Knight Cup Div.II - (About) 1400 Metres. Maiden Indian Horses 3 years old only (Terms) (10 Runners)

MYSTIC MUSIC (Imran Chisty) jumped awkwardly inwards and inconvenienced CROZIET (P. Mani) on its inside soon after jumping out of the starting gates.

NEW EMPEROR (V.R. Jagadeesh) sustained bleeding cut injury on right hind cannon.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f LUCIA.

# 2<sup>nd</sup> Race: 233. The Icebreaker Stakes - (About) 1600 Metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over (8 Runners)

Trainer Mr. S. Britto was fined Rs.2,000/- for not bringing his charge KING OF HEROES (Arshad Alam) to the weighing scales for weighing when he was specifically informed to do so.

FORMULA ONE (Shobhan Babu) planted and did not take any part in the race. In view of its behaviour Trainer Mr. G. Nityanand was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in two Mock Races on race days on the race track.

Jockey Dashrat Singh, the rider of PROM QUEEN, reported that he lost his right stirrup soon after jumping out of the starting gates which he regained within a few strides.

Trainer Mr. Warren Singh and Jockey B. Mahesh were questioned regarding the running and riding of MY LAW. The Trainer stated that he had asked the Jockey to keep it covered for most part of the race and towards the end to pull out and show the horse day light and ride it out. But as the horse was drawn 8 in the race, the Jockey tried his

Trainer Mr. J. Babu Rao was questioned regarding the relatively poor performance of his charge ARUN as compared to its previous runs of the Bangalore Winter Meeting 2013-14 (especially as his charge has been running very frequently during the season). He was further cautioned that a repetition of similar manner of running of his charge would entail him being reported to the Stewards for severe disciplinary action.

An enquiry is being held into the inconsistent pattern of running and the relatively improved performance of PROM QUEEN trained by Mr. V. Narayana Gowda and ridden by Jockey Dashrat Singh as compared to its run in race No.205, The Classic Story Plate-(About) 1400 Metres, Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over of the Bangalore Winter Meeting 2013-14 when ridden by Jockey G. Adarsh it ran unplaced.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b m PROM QUEEN.

# 3<sup>rd</sup> Race: 234. The Ardent Knight Cup Div.I - (About) 1400 Metres. Maiden Indian Horses 3 years old only (Terms) (9 Runners)

SUPER MISSILE (K. Chethana) jumped awkwardly outwards and inconvenienced VIVID IMPRESSION (J.H. Christopher) on its outside soon after jumping out of the starting gates.

CONJURER (S.K. Paswan) ran detached from the field. Trainer Mr. Faraz Arshad was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

Jockey Suraj Narredu, the rider of TO THE FUTURE reported that his mount was hanging out after entering the straight. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination and no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Hidayat Khan was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch c BIG TICKET.

### 4<sup>th</sup> Race: 235. The Manasa Sarovara Stakes - (About) 1200 Metres. Horses rated 40 to 65 (8 Runners)

Jockey P. Mani, the rider of TONY MONTANA, was fined Rs.2,000/- for shifting out and bumping SMOKEY SID (Imran Chisty) which in turn passed it on to SALZBURG (R. Vaibhav) on his outside passing the 1100 Metres.

Jockey Arshad Alam, the rider of CONROD, was fined Rs.2,000/- for shifting out and causing interference to TONY MONTANA (P. Mani) on

Jockey Ryan Marshall, the rider of AZETIC STAR, was fined Rs.1,000/- for the excessive use of the whip on his mount during the race ( $1^{\rm st}$  infringement).

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b g AZETIC STAR.

## 5<sup>th</sup> Race: 236. The B.T.C. Stewards Trophy - (About) 1200 Metres. Horses rated 80 and above (12 Runners)

Jockey Arshad Alam, the rider of MR CARPE, reported that he could not get a clear run soon after jumping out of the starting gates due to crowding of the field.

RAPHIRE (A. Vishwanath) planted, lost many lengths at the start and ran detached from the field thereafter. In view of its behaviour Trainer Mr. S. Inayathulla was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in one Mock Race on a race day on the race track.

Jockey Suraj Narredu, the rider of WILL STAR, reported that his mount abruptly stopped galloping after entering the straight. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. B. Puttanna was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again

Jockey Dashrat Singh, the rider of ETHOPHIAN, reported that he could not get a clear run passing the 900 Metres due to a closely packed field.

Jockey J.H. Christopher, the rider of ABSOLUTE MAJORITY, was fined Rs.1,000/- for coming in and causing interference to CAPE FERRAT (Y.S. Srinath) on his inside passing the 300 Metres.

It was reported after the race that the right fore shoe of SECRET PUNCH (B. Mahesh) had apparently come off during the race.

IRON MARSHALL (K.P.G. Appu) sustained cut injury on right fore cannon.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f LIGHT OF SUCCESS.

# 6<sup>th</sup> Race: 237. The Tungabhadra Stakes - (About) 1400 Metres. Horses rated 40 to 65, 5 years old and over (10 Runners)

Jockey Saddam Hussain, the rider of STRIVE AND SERVE, reported that his mount abruptly stopped galloping in the final 200 Metres of the race. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but

It was reported after the race that CHIRON (A. Vishwanath) burst its blood vessels. Trainer Mr. Hidayat Khan was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

An enquiry is being held into the inconsistent running of ACTIVE GREY trained by Mr. V. Narayana Gowda and ridden by Jockey Dashrat Singh in the above race.

ACTIVE GREY (Dashrat Singh) sustained a cut injury on right hind fetlock.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner gr m ACTIVE GREY.

### **7<sup>th</sup> Race:** 238. The Karwar Stakes - (About) 1200 Metres. Horses rated 20 to 45 (12 Runners)

Trainer Mr. S. Narredu was fined Rs.1,000/- for the delayed submission of scratching form in respect of his charge SUPER SILVER in the above race.

PRAZSKY (R. Vaibhav) jumped awkwardly inwards and inconvenienced SAPHIRA (V.R. Jagadeesh) on his inside soon after jumping out of the starting gates. .

Jockey A. Vishwanath, the rider of FEET ON FIRE, was fined Rs.1,000/for coming in and causing interference to STORMER (Imran Chisty) on his inside passing the 900 Metres.

VIGOROUS (Y.S. Srinath) sustained gum injury.

STANDING TALL (Kiran Naidu) sustained gum injury.

STORMER (Imran Chisty) sustained bleeding cut injury on left hind cannon.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b g ALWAYS REMEMBERING.

#### 8<sup>th</sup> Race: 239. The Mekedatu Stakes - (About) 1400 Metres. Horses rated 00 to 25, 5 years old and over (12 Runners)

Trainer Mr. Pradeep Annaiah was fined Rs.2,000/- for declaring Jockey P. Kiran Rai when he was medically unfit. Subsequently permission was granted to him to declare Jockey A.R. Pradeep to ride YOURE A STAR in the above race.

As Jockey Saddam Hussain, the declared rider of MOUNTAIN STORM was certified medically unfit to ride after his ride in the  $6^{\text{th}}$  race,

NATION'S GLORY (Imran Chisty) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour Trainer Mr. B. Puttanna was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in one jump out on starting gate practice day.

It was reported after the lastrace that YOURE A STAR (A.R. Pradeep) burst its blood vessels (Endosecopy Grade III) at 6.25 p.m. Trainer Mr. Pradeep Annaiah was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

MOUNTAIN STORM (Irvan Singh) sustained cut injury on right gaskin.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g THUNDER.
