RACING INCIDENTS
(240 - 246)

Going : Good

Penetrometer Reading : 2.4 Cms.

False Rails: Average width of 6.5 Metres from 1600 Metres to the winning post.

1st Race: 240. The Bhadravathi Plate – (About) 1400 Metres. Horses rated 00 to 25 (11 Runners)

Jockey Shobhan Babu, the rider of MR CHARM, was fined Rs.2,000/- for coming in and causing interference to SILHOUETTE (B. Mahesh) on his inside which in turn passed it on to LIQUID ASSET (J.H. Christopher) along the rails passing the 950 Metres.

Jockey Arshad Alam, the rider of OPTIMISTIC, was fined Rs.3,000/- for shifting in and causing interference to BEL ESPRIT (Suraj Narredu) which in turn passed it on to BIG COPPER PENNY (P. Kiran Rai) along the rails passing the 300 Metres.

Jockey K. Raja Rao, the rider of WHITE SNOWDROPS, was fined Rs.3,000/- for not making sufficient effort on his mount during the race.

OPTIMISTIC (Arshad Alam) sustained bleeding cut injuries on left hind and right hind coronet.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g OPTIMISTIC.

2nd Race: 241. The Vijayanagar Trophy – (About) 1100 Metres. Maiden Indian Horses 3 years old only (Terms) (11 Runners)

MADAME AYESHA (T.S. Jodha) violently veered out passing the 900 Metres despite the best efforts of the rider to keep it on an even course thereby taking out SHAFT (Imran Chisty) and ASIAN STAR (M. Noornabi) on its outside. Subsequently MADAME AYESHA (T.S. Jodha) and SHAFT (Imran Chisty) raced on the outer sand track thereafter. MADAME AYESHA (T.S. Jodha) was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. F. Sirajuddin was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Trainer Mr. Amit Caddy and Jockey K. Raja Rao, the Trainer and rider respectively of SOUTH PACIFIC were questioned regarding the running and riding of this horse in the above race. The rider said that the horse

to have sharp molars on both the sides. Hence Trainer Mr. Amit Caddy was fined Rs.3,000/- for his negligence (1st infringement). Nevertheless the Trainer and the rider were informed that in view of the ailment detected, they were given the benefit of doubt at this instance and Trainer Mr. Amit Caddy was cautioned as to the future running of his charges and Jockey K. Raja Rao as to his future riding in races.

MADAME AYESHA (T.S. Jodha) sustained bleeding cut injury on right hind cannon.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner gr f PURE ALLURE.

3rd Race: 242. The Champion Trainer Trophy - (About) 1400 Metres. Horses rated 40 to 65 (7 Runners)

Permission was granted to Trainer Mr. B. Prithviraj to withdraw DIAMOND QUEST (P. Kiran Rai) on veterinary grounds as it was found to have sustained cut injury on left fore bulb of the heel inside with inflammation. He was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Jockey A. Sundaram, the rider of LOVELY LADY, was fined Rs.1,000/- for shifting in and causing interference to ACE LEXINGTON (Suraj Narredu) on his inside passing the 400 Metres.

Jockey V.R. Jagadeesh, the rider of ALL PROOF, reported that his mount was hanging out in the final 200 Metres. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. G. Nityanand was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Jockey G. Adarsh, the rider of DANCE WITH ME, reported that he lost his whip passing the 400 Metres.

Jockey V.R. Jagadeesh, the rider of ALL PROOF, reported that he lost his whip approaching the 100 Metres.

BRIGHT LADY (M.D. Praveen) ran detached from the field. Trainer Mr. S. Narredu was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f ARTA.

4th Race: 243. The Ashwapriya Trophy - (About) 1600 Metres. Horses rated 40 to 65, 5 years old and over (8 Runners)

Jockey Suraj Narredu the rider of SUPREME, placed 3rd by the Judge objected against Jockey Y.S. Srinath, the rider of GREY CONNECTION placed 2nd for "in the last 100 Metres GREY CONNECTION shifted out from the rails very violently and bumped and bored my horse whereby

An enquiry is being held into the manner of riding of Jockey Y.S. Srinath on his mount GREYCONNECTION in the above race.

An enquiry is being held into the relative performance of ATLAS POWER, the winner of the above race, trained by Mr. Sharat Kumar and ridden by Jockey J.H. Christopher as compared to its previous runs during Bangalore Winter Meeting 2013-14.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g ATLAS POWER.

5th Race: 244. The Magadi Plate Div.II - (About) 1200 Metres. Horses rated 20 to 45 (9 Runners)

SEVEN OF HEARTS (B. Mahesh) planted and lost many lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour Trainer Mr. Sharat Kumar was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in one Mock Race on a race day on the race track.

It was observed that SUPER SILVER (Suraj Narredu) was hanging in after entering the straight. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. S. Narredu was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

SUMMER VILLE (J.H. Christopher) ran detached from the field. Trainer Mr. Amit Caddy was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

Jockey P. Mani, the rider of COURAGEOUS, was reprimanded for dropping hands before passing the winning post.

It was reported after the race that SEVEN OF HEARTS (B. Mahesh) pulled up lame on right fore due to a sprained fetlock joint. Trainer Mr. Sharat Kumar was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g LUC DIVINE.

6th Race: 245. The Makalidurga Plate - (About) 1400 Metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over (11 Runners)

Jockey P. Kiran Rai, the rider of SOVIET MELODY, reported that his mount was hanging out after entering the straight. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. S. Britto was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Jockey Arshad Alam, the rider of FIORITTA, placed 2nd by the Judge objected against Jockey Suraj Narredu, the rider of CLUELESS placed First for "in the last 400 Metres CLUELESS came on to him and closed the gap and in the 100 Metres CLUELESS shifted course and whereby my filly shied away which cost me a certain race". The Stewards held an enquiry immediately after the race and examined the Jockeys concerned. After deliberations they decided to overrule the objection. Jockey Ch K Chary, the rider of THE FIRST BULLET was fined Rs.1,000/- for not maintaining a straight course in the final 100 Metres of the race.

Jockey Suraj Narredu, the rider of CLUELESS, was fined Rs.3,000/- for not maintaining a straight course thereby causing interference to AFFRIKAH (Ryan Marshall) in the final 50 Metres of the race.

It was reported after the race that AFFRIKAH (Ryan Marshall) pulled up lame on left fore. Trainer Mr. Arjun Mangalorkar was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Surprise Sample was taken for analysis from b m FIORITTA.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g CLUELESS.

7th Race: 246. The Magadi Plate Div.I - (About) 1200 Metres. Horses rated 20 to 45 (9 Runners)

SECRET TOUCH (T.S. Jodha) was fractious at the starting gates and was examined by the Club's Veterinary Officer who reported that it was found to have lost its left incisor tooth. Under the circumstances it was permitted to be withdrawn on veterinary grounds before coming under Starter's orders. Trainer Mr. F. Sirajuddin was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Jockey A. Vishwanath, the rider of CHAMPAKALI, was fined Rs.3,000/- for completely easing his mount in the final 50 Metres of the race.

VIGOROUS (Y.S. Srinath) sustained gum injury.

ASSIDUOUS (A.R. Prqadeep) sustained cut injury on left hind cannon.

Surprise Sample was taken for analysis from ch g MAGIC WAVE.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch f SUN
