1200 Metres. Horses rated 00 to 25, 5 years old and over (8 Runners)

SAYYONEE (P. Kiran Rai) sustained a cut injury on left hind cannon.

BOLD PILOT (Arshad Alam) sustained a cut injury on right hind cannon.

Surprise Sample was taken for analysis from dk b g DOMINATOR.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g ENCOURAGER.

2nd Race: 248. The Champion Jockey Trophy – Div.II - (About) 1200 Metres. Maiden Indian horses 3 years old only (Terms) (10 Runners)

The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Warren Singh was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Jockey Imran Chisty, the rider of VENCEDORA, reported that his saddle shifted back within the first 50 Metres of the start. After due examination of the equipment, Trainer Mr. Arjun Mangalorkar was fined Rs.3,000/- for faulty saddling.

Permission was granted to Trainer Mr. Prasanna Kumar to withdraw AMAZING REDD (Imran Chisty) on veterinary grounds as it was found to be suffering from right anaxillary sinusitis (thick yellowish unilateral discharge from right nostril). He was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Trainer Mr. Samar Singh was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Jockey P. Kiran Rai, the rider of VIRAT, reported that his mount was hanging in after entering the straight. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. V. Narayana Gowda was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

VIRAT (P. Kiran Rai) accidentally stumbled approaching the 200 Metres.

It was reported after the race that ALCAZAAR (Shobhan Babu) pulled up lame on right hind due to sprained fetlock. Trainer Mr. Sharat Kumar was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.
