PENETROMETER READING: 3.4 Cms

RAILING POSITION: Railing fixed at average width of 4.5 Meters from 1600 Meters to winning post from its original position.

1st Race: 53. The Gulbarga Plate - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 00 to 20 (10 Runners).

DANCING PRINCESS (M. Prabhakaran) jumped awkwardly inwards onto CLASSIC SPEED (Darshan R.N) soon after the start.

It was observed that GLORIOUS DAYS (P. S. Chouhan) was inclined to run out between 900 Metres and 700 Metres.

It was observed that DUTY CALL (R. Ajinkya) was lugging 'in' under pressure in the final 200 Metres of the race.

TRACK STRIKER (Raghu K) ran detached from the field. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. M. Rajendra Singh was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f MUSIC DIVINE.

2nd Race: 54. The Bugs Bunny Plate - (About) 1100 metres. Maiden Horses 2 years old only. (8 Runners).

INVICTA (Antony Raj S.) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Prasanna Kumar was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey Imran Chisty, the rider of PORT OF BEAUTY reported that his mount was running green throughout the race.

It was observed that LOVEMYBOSS (Harish B.) was running green throughout the race.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch c STAR CAVALRY.

3rd Race: 55. The Longchamp Plate - Div. II - (About) 1100 metres. Horses rated 15 to 35 (12 Runners).

SIMONE (Mudassar Nazar) was extremely fractious in the gates and it was observed after the race that the bit had turned to the wrong side.

Jockey D'nuSingh Deora, the rider of IDO WHAT I DO was fined Rs. 3,000/- for coming 'in' and causing interference to the horses on his inside viz; ANGELS KISS (Antony Raj S.), MY LEXICON (Nazerul Alam) and ANOTHER RAINBOW (Sunil Samson) soon after jumping of the starting gates.

Jockey Nazerul Alam, the rider of MY LEXICON reported that his mount was hanging out badly after passing the 700 Metres and raced on the outer portion of the track thereafter. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination. On examination, it was found to have pulled up lame on left fore. Trainer Mr. Neil Darashah was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

DESERT GOLD (Shamaz Shareef) was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f ANGELS KISS.

4th Race: 56. The Madhugiri Plate - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 30 to 50, 4 years old and over (11 Runners).

MARIKO (R.Ajinkya) was examined at the starting gate by the Club's Veterinary Officer and was found to be trotting lame on right fore. Under the circumstances, it was permitted to be withdrawn on veterinary grounds before coming under Starter's order. Trainer Mr.V. Lokanath was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

ROSEBROOK (P. S. Chouhan) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.S. Dominic was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

SIYOUNI (Darshan R.N) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.S. Narredu was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

OPENING ACT (Sunil Samson) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Samar Singh was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey Ashok Kumar A., the rider of GRAND EMPIRE was reprimanded for shifting 'in' and inconveniencing CALL ME MAYBE (Vinod Shinde) on his inside passing the 700 Metres.

Jockey A.R.Pradeep, the rider of REGENCY GIRL was reprimanded for travelling wide rounding the final bend for no apparent reason.

GRAND EMPIRE (Ashok Kumar A.) was impounded for veterinary examination. On examination, it was found to have pulled up lame on left fore. Trainer Mr.S. Ganapathy was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

BLUEJACK (Tauseef Ahmed) was impounded for veterinary examination. On examination, it was found to have burst its blood vessels (Endoscopy Grade - III) and also sustained clipped injury on left hind outer bulb of heel.

Trainer Mr. F. Sirajuddin was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f PANAMA.

5th Race: 57. The Stewards Trophy - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 60 and above (11 Runners).

ROYAL SERENITY (Raghu K) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Rajesh Narredu was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey Anjar Alam, the rider of GYPSY was reprimanded for riding an indifferent race.

It was reported after the race that KRIEGER (Darshan R.N) burst its blood vessels. Trainer Mr. S. Ganapathy (deputizing on behalf of trainer Mr. Aravind. G) was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

It was reported after the race that UNGOOGLEABLE (Manish R) pulled up lame on right fore. Trainer Mr. Samar Singh was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b c DIAMOND RAYS.

6th Race: 58. The Ashoka Chakra Cup - (About) 1800 metres. 3 years old and over. (6 Runners).

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g BIG SUR.

7th Race: 59. The Pratap Stud Plate - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 45 to 65 (10 Runners).

Jockey Anjar Alam, the rider of AKHA TEEJ reported that his mount was not galloping fluently throughout the race. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination. On examination, it was found to have sharp molars. Trainer Mr. R. V. Manohar was fined Rs.3,000/- for his negligence (1st infringement).

Jockey Sunil Samson, the rider of HARLEY QUINN reported that he accidentally lost his whip passing the 350 Metres.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b f LADY LEGEND.

8th Race: 60. The Longchamp Plate - Div. I - (About) 1100 metres. Horses rated 15 to 35 (12 Runners).

BIRCHWOOD (Md.Akram) reared up as the gates opened and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Prithviraj B. was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b f YERWAZAN.

Permission was granted to trainers M/s. S. Ganapathy, S. Inayathulla, S.S. Attaollahi, Parvathi Byramji and G. Nityanand to deputise on behalf of trainers M/s. Aravind.G, Faraz Arshad, Arjun Manglorkar, Darius R. Byramji and S. Padmanabhan and who were unable to attend the races.
