# **RAILING POSITION:** Railing fixed at average width of 4.5 Meters from 1600 Meters to winning post from its original position.

# 1<sup>st</sup> Race: 167. The Flashing Star Plate - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 00 to 20 (11 Runners).

FLICKA (Ashok Kumar A.) was extremely fractious, reared up, sat down for a considerable period of time and the nose band snapped. Under the circumstances, it was permitted to be withdrawn before coming under Starter's order.

MAYURANA (P. S. Chouhan) planted and lost many lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Prithviraj B. was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

DESERT GOLD (Mohammed Aliyar) planted and lost many lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Mahmood Khan was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

REVERENCE (G Sai Vamshi) jumped out awkwardly.

REVERENCE (G Sai Vamshi) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch g DONTBREAKTHERULES.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Race: 168. The Netravati Plate - Div. II - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 15 to 35, 5 years old and over (11 Runners).

TYTO ALBA (Ajeet Kumar) was extremely fractious and injured its rider. Under the circumstances, it was permitted to be withdrawn before coming under Starter's order.

It was observed that the left side of the bridle of RED INDIAN (V.R.Jagadeesh) had shifted onto the blinker soon after the start. Hence, Trainer Mr. R. V. Manohar was fined Rs.2,000/- for his negligence in discharge of his duties as a trainer.

Jockey Arshad Alam, the rider of CADILLAC SKY was fined Rs.1,000/- for travelling wide from 600 Metres till about 400 Metres for no apparent reason.

Jockey Kiran Rai P, the rider of LIMATO was fined Rs.2,000/- for shifting 'in' under the use of whip and tightening AZEEMKI PRINCESS (Irvan Singh) on his inside between the 350 Metres till about 200 Metres.

ANAKIN (Y. S. Srinath) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch g INDUSTRIALIST.

### <u>3<sup>rd</sup> Race: 169. The Man 'O' War Plate - (About) 1100 metres. Horses</u> <u>3 years old only (Outstation horses eligible). (12 Runners).</u>

PERFECTIMAGINATION (Neeraj Rawal) was slightly slowly away.

PRERANA (Irvan Singh) was slightly slowly away.

Jockey Y. S. Srinath, the rider of RULE OF ENGAGEMENT was reprimanded for shifting out and inconveniencing BELLATOR (P. Trevor) on his outside approaching 850 Metres.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f BALTIMORE.

### 4<sup>th</sup> Race: 170. The Gaganachukki Plate - Div. I - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 15 to 35 (10 Runners).

POLAR EXPRESS (Imran Chisty) jumped out awkwardly and inconvenienced PARADISO (Arshad Alam) at the start.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner gr f SILVER SWIFT.

### 5<sup>th</sup> Race: 171. The Netravati Plate - Div. I - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 15 to 35, 5 years old and over (12 Runners).

ANDRA KING (Darshan R.N) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b m LE MARC.

### 6<sup>th</sup> Race: 172. The Narasimharaja Trophy - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 45 to 65 (11 Runners).

SUN POWER (Manish .R) was examined at the starting gate by the Club's Veterinary Officer and was found to be trotting lame on left fore. Under the circumstances, it was permitted to be withdrawn on veterinary grounds before coming under Starter's order. Trainer Mr.Imtiaz Khan was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Jockey Arvind Kumar, the rider of SIDE WINDER was fined Rs. 2,000/- for shifting 'in' and tightening the horses on his inside viz; ROYAL RESOLUTION (David Allan) and KNOTTY OAK (S. John), whereby KNOTTY OAK (S. John) which was travelling directly behind had to be checked passing the 1000 Metres.

Jockey Antony Raj S., the rider of SPANISH BEAUTY was fined Rs. 2,000/for shifting 'in' and causing interference to BIG BOON (Chethan Gowda) on his inside approaching 700 Metres.

Jockey S. John, the rider of KNOTTY OAK was fined Rs.1,000/- for shifting 'in' and causing interference to BIG BOON (Chethan Gowda) on his inside, which in turn passed it onto SIDE WINDER (Arvind Kumar) passing the 150 Metres.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch m SPANISH BEAUTY.

### 7<sup>th</sup> Race: 173. The Malaprabha Plate - (About) 2000 metres. Horses rated 30 to 50 (7 Runners).

Trainer Mr. Aravind G. was fined Rs.5,000/- for not obtaining prior permission to use Dextor Ring Bit on his charge PLAY SAFE (Chethan Gowda). Subsequently, permission was granted to him to use Dextor Ring Bit before horse left the paddock.

Jockey P. Trevor, the rider of AFERPI reported that his mount was hanging 'in' throughout the race. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Prasanna Kumar was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f CRACK OF DAWN.

### 8<sup>th</sup> Race: 174. The Gaganachukki Plate - Div. II - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 15 to 35 (11 Runners).

Trainer Mr. Imtiaz Khan was fined Rs.2,000/- for not obtaining prior permission for the use of Cross Nose Band on his charge DESERT COMBAT (Arshad Alam). Subsequently, Cross Nose Band was removed before the horse left paddock.

ANNIE'S SONG (Irvan Singh) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Neil B Devaney (is deputizing on behalf of Trainer Mrs. Parvati Byramji) was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey Arshad Alam, the rider of DESERT COMBAT reported that his mount was hanging out from 800 Metres. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination. On examination, it was found to have sharp molars on both sides. Hence Trainer Mr. Imtiaz Khan was fined Rs.3,000/- for his negligence (1<sup>st</sup> infringement).

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b g MR HUMBLE.

SHIVALIK SHOW (trained by Mr. Azhar Ali) which had shown the presence of **PHENYLBUTAZONE and OXYPHENBUTAZONE** (Class- IV) prohibited substance – the sample of which was taken after the said horse placed First in the above race.

The Stewards noted the following:

The trainer/owner were given the option of sending the split sample of the urine for confirmatory analysis. The trainer vide his letter dated 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 informed the Club that he did not wish to exercise the above option of sending the split sample to The Horseracing Forensic Laboratory, New Market, U.K. or Hong Kong Jockey Club, Hong Kong.

Therefore, the Stewards decided to disqualify the horse **b.m. SHIVALIK SHOW** from the above race and revise the order of placings as under:-

Therefore, the Stewards decided to disqualify the horse **ch g HUNTERS MOON** from the above race and revise the order of placings as under:-
