RACING INCIDENTS

<u>(73-80)</u>

GOING : Good PENETROMETER READING: 3.4 Cms. RAILING POSITION: Railing fixed at its original position.

1st Race: 73. The Novice Plate - (About) 1200 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only. (8 Runners).

Jockey A. Sandesh, the rider of NOBLE RULER reported that his mount was running green throughout the race.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b f SCRUPLES.

2nd Race: 74. The Devarayanadurga Plate - (About) 1100 metres. Horses rated 00 to 20 (Whips not allowed) (14 Runners).

Trainer Mr. Warren Singh was fined Rs.5,000/- for discrepancy in shoeing in respect of his charge GLOBAL RULER (1st infringement).

HEAVENLY ANGEL (Chandrashekar.M) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.V. Lokanath was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

SCINTILLA (Surya P.) jumped awkwardly outwards.

It was observed that Jockey V.R.Jagadeesh, the rider of GLOBAL RULER had to check and steady his mount to avoid striking the front runner ICONIC PRINCESS (Shreyas Singh) approaching 400 Metres.

It was reported after the race that GLOBAL RULER (V.R.Jagadeesh) burst its blood vessels. Trainer Mr. Warren Singh was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

BAROG (Naveen M.) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch r COUNTRY'S JEWEL.

<u>3rd Race: 75. The Dharmasthala Plate - Div. II - (About) 1400</u> metres. Horses rated 15 to 35 (14 Runners).

Jockey Darshan R.N, the rider of GOLDEN MEMORY was fined Rs.5,000/- for shifted 'in' and causing severe interference to TOP NEWS (Rayan Ahmed R.) on his inside passing the 1200 Metres.

Jockey Prashant P.Dhebe, the rider of BAHURUPAH reported that his mount was inclined to run out between the 700 Metres and 500 Metres. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Jockey D. Patel, the rider of SMITHSONIAN was fined Rs.2,000/- for shifting out and causing interference to TOP NEWS (Rayan Ahmed R.) on his outside passing the 250 Metres.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f WATCHMYSTARS.

<u>4th Race: 76. The Mercara Plate - (About) 2000 metres. Horses rated</u> <u>30 to 50 (8 Runners).</u>

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch g SPORTING MEMORIES.

5th Race: 77. The New Year Cup(Grade III) - (About) 1400 metres. 4 years old and over at the time of starting. (6 Runners).

Jockey A. Sandesh, the rider of MULTIFACETED was fined Rs.3,000/- for making undesirable gesture immediately after passing the winning post.

An enquiry is being held into the relative improved performance of MULTIFACETED, trained by Mr. Darius R. Byramji and ridden by Jockey A. Sandesh in the above race as compared to its previous run in Race No.30 i.e., The Bangalore Turf Club Trophy (Grade-III) (About) 1200 Meters, 3 years old and over run on 21st November, 2020 where it ran unplaced.

6th Race: 78. The Bangalore Oaks(Grade II) - (About) 2400 metres. 4-year-old Indian Fillies (Foaled in 2017) (10 Runners).

Compulsory urine and blood samples were taken for analysis from the following I,II & III placed horses viz:

dk b f ANTIBES I

b f RAMBUNCTIOUS II

b f LAKE TAHOE III

<u>7th Race: 79. The Lalit Mahal Plate - (About) 1200 metres. Horses</u> rated 60 and above (14 Runners).

At the behest of the Stipendiary Stewards, the Stewards ordered and held an enquiry with specific reference to the start of the race.

The Stewards after detailed deliberations and eliciting the opinion on the Stipendiary Stewards decided that:

- a) As it was not a fair start they declared the race Null & Void in terms of Rule No. 31 (a) of the BTC Rules of Racing;
- b) To declare the bets with totalisator pool or pools as Null & Void in terms of Rule No. 31 (b) of the BTC Rules of Racing;

Further, directed the Stipendiary Stewards to conduct a detailed enquiry and submit a report.

8th Race: 80. The Dharmasthala Plate - Div. I - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 15 to 35 (14 Runners).

Jockey M. Prabhakaran replaced the indisposed Jockey Irvan Singh on DEFINITIVE.

Jockey Kiran Rai P replaced the indisposed Jockey Anjar Alam on ZEHNASEEB.

CANOTINA (Antony Raj S.) planted and took no practical part in the race. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Arjun Mangalorkar was informed not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

TENALI (Chetan Kalay.S) took a fly jump at the start.

It was observed that Jockey Arul J.H., the rider of ACASTER had to steady his mount to avoid striking the front runner TENALI (Chetan Kalay.S) passing the 500 Metres.

Jockey Surya.P, the rider of ROSY RAPUNZEL was fined Rs.1,000/- for shifting out and causing interference to TENALI (Chetan Kalay.S)on his outside passing the 350 Metres.

Jockey M. Prabhakaran, the rider of DEFINITIVE was fined Rs.1,000/- for shifting out and causing interference to HABANERO (Rayan Ahmed R.) on his outside passing the 100 Metres.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b c FOREVER TOGETHER.

Permission was granted to trainers M/s. S. Dominic and S.S. Attaollahi to deputize on behalf of trainers M/s. B. Prithviraj and Vishal Gaikwad who were unable to attend the races.

After questioning all concerned our primary finding is that the horse drawn 14 was very fractious and reared up at least a couple of time which may have cause the gates 13 & 14 to malfunction. The Starter was further questioned about the horse drawn 12 the starter accidentally admitted his mistake and stated that he had informed the handlers of the horses drawn 12 not leave it but the end or remove the blind till the end. However, as the horses were playing up he missed out and inadvertently gave a start. He once again apologized mistake again.
