BANGALORE WINTER MEETING 2021-22 EIGHTH DAY, THURSDAY, 25TH NOVEMBER, 2021 RACING INCIDENTS

<u>(51 - 58)</u>

GOING: Heavy

PENETROMETER READING: 6.1 Cms.

RAILING POSITION: Railing fixed at average width of 6.0 Meters from 1600 Meters to winning post from its original position.

1st Race: 51. The Narmada Plate - Div. III - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 00 to 25, to be ridden by Indian Jockeys claiming allowance (Whips not allowed) (11 Runners).

It was observed that BARONESS (Angad) jumped out awkwardly whereby Jockey lost his right stirrup and he was totally unbalanced, unseated from his mount soon after the start, thereafter the horse ran rider less.

BARONESS (Angad) sustained severe injury on Mandible.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner gr f PRERANA.

2nd Race: 52. The Half A Crown Plate - (About) 1600 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only. (9 Runners).

Permission was granted to Trainer Mr. Irfan Ghatala to withdraw LIMITED EDITION (Anjar Alam) on veterinary grounds as it was found to have abrasion on both hind pastern and right hind fetlock. He was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

FUN AND LAUGHTER (Antony Raj S.) sustained bleeding cut injury on left hind pastern.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f ETERNAL BLAZE.

3rd Race: 53. The Narmada Plate - Div. II - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 00 to 25, to be ridden by Indian Jockeys claiming allowance (Whips not allowed) (11 Runners).

Jockey S. Hussain, the rider of AEROSPEED placed 2nd by the judge objected against Jockey Arul J.H, the rider of SILVERITA placed 1st for "In the last 100 Metres the winner shifted out and cut across me and also bumped me which cost me a certain race." The Stewards held an enquiry immediately after the race and interviewed the Jockeys concerned. After deliberations, they decided to overrule the objection.

Jockey Arul J.H, the rider of SILVERITA was fined Rs.5,000/- for not maintaining a straight course in the final 50 Metres of the race, thereby inconveniencing AEROSPEED (S. Hussain) on his outside.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f SILVERITA.

4th Race: 54. The Count Fleet Plate - (About) 1100 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only. (11 Runners).

CHIRAAG (P. Mani) dropped rider on the way to starting gates and bolted, fell near mile marker on inner sand track and thereafter the horse ran rider less on the tar road. Under the circumstances, it was permitted to be

withdrawn on veterinary grounds before coming under Starter's order. Trainer Mr. S. Inayathulla was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

THE ADVISER (P. Sai Kumar) took a fly jump.

STAR OF THE HILLS (Kiran Rai P) jumped awkwardly outwards and inconvenienced TACTICAL COMMAND (Darshan R.N) at the start.

Jockey Vishal N Bunde, the rider of LAUTERBRUNNEN reported that his mount was hanging 'in' after entering the straight. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Prithviraj B. was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Jockey Akshay Kumar, the rider of MATERA reported that his mount was making a roaring noise while pulling up his mount after the race. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination. On examination, it was found to have burst its blood vessels and dorsal displacement of soft palate (On endoscopy Grade - III). Trainer Mrs. Parvati Byramji was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

DOMINA (Ryan Marshall) sustained superficial clip injury on left hind cannon.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g THOUSAND WORDS.

5th Race: 55. The Chatrapathi Trophy - (About) 1600 metres. Horses rated 40 to 65, 4 years old and over (9 Runners).

GREEN CHANNEL (Darshan R.N) ran detached from the field. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Neil B. Devaney was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

INDIAN PHARAOH (Ryan Marshall) ran detached from the field. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Kishan Thomas was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f LAKE TAHOE.

6th Race: 56. The Ashoka Chakra Cup - (About) 1800 metres. 3 years old and over (5 Runners).

Jockey A. Sandesh, the rider of SOVEREIGN LEGEND reported that his mount was not galloping fluently in the final 150 Metres as such he stopped riding. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b c LAGARDE.

7th Race: 57. The Dabbe Falls Plate - (About) 1600 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 4 years old and over (9 Runners).

IMPELLING POWER (Nazerul Alam) bolted on the way to starting gates, broke the railing at 200 Metres and thereafter the horse ran rider less on the tar road. Under the circumstances, it was permitted to be withdrawn on veterinary grounds before coming under Starter's order. Trainer Mr.Prasanna

Kumar was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

TYTO ALBA (Rajesh Kumar M) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Narayana Gowda V. was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey Arul J.H, the rider of ALMANACH was reprimanded for shifting 'in' and inconveniencing OMBUDSMAN (Darshan R.N) on his inside passing the 700 Metres.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g ALMANACH.

8th Race: 58. The Narmada Plate - Div. I - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 00 to 25, to be ridden by Indian Jockeys claiming allowance (Whips not allowed) (11 Runners).

It was observed that STRIKING SUPPORT (K.G. Likith Appu) had apparently lost its right hind shoe during the race.

It was observed that Jockey Shreyas Singh. S, the rider of TENALI had to steady his mount to avoid striking the front runner LIGHTNING CHARLIE (Vishal N Bunde) passing the 900 Metres.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g LUCKY CHANCE.
