RAILING POSITION: Railing fixed at average width of 8.0 Meters from 1600 Meters to winning post from its original position.

<u>1st Race: 68. The Smarty Jones Plate - (About) 1400 metres. Maiden</u> <u>Horses 3 years old only. (9 Runners).</u>

NOBLE RULER (Kiran Rai P) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. S. Ganapathy was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey Darshan R.N, the rider of KLOCKNER was reprimanded for shifting 'in and inconveniencing LINKIN PARK (Arul J.H) on his inside passing the 400 Metres.

Jockey Neeraj Rawal, the rider of SACRAMENT reported that his mount was lugging out under pressure in the final 100 Metres of the race.

DEFINING POWER (D'nuSingh Deora) was impounded for veterinary examination. On examination, it was found to have bit sore on left buccal mucosa. However, Trainer Mr. Prasanna Kumar was informed to take corrective appropriate measures before accepting with it again.

SACRAMENT (Neeraj Rawal) sustained gum injury.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from b g DEFINING POWER.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f ICELANDIC.

2nd Race: 69. The Mahanadi Plate - (About) 1600 metres. Horses rated 00 to 25, 4 years old and over (12 Runners).

AMALFI SUNRISE (Arshad Alam) was slowly away and lost many lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Rajesh Narredu was informed not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

SKIATHOS (Arul J.H) planted, lost many lengths and did not raise a fluent gallop for the first 100 Metres. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.S. Dominic was informed not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

OZARK (Manish R) accidentally brushed the rails approaching 1200 Metres.

It was observed that SKIATHOS (Arul J.H) struck the front runner NICHE CANNABIS (Vishal N Bunde), totally unbalancing Jockey Arul J.H who was dislodged from his mount passing the 400 Metres and the horse ran rider less thereafter.

SKIATHOS (Arul J.H) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

It was reported after the race that ALTAIR (P. Sai Kumar) had apparently lost its left hind shoe during the race.

It was reported after the race that NICHE CANNABIS (Vishal N Bunde) had apparently lost its left fore shoe during the race.

An enquiry is being held into the running and riding of AMALFI SUNRISE, trained by Mr. Rajesh Narredu and ridden by Jockey Arshad Alam in the above race.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch g SHAN E AZEEM.

<u>3rd Race: 70. The Daria Daulat Trophy - (About) 2000 metres. Horses</u> rated 20 to 45 (6 Runners).

CANDLELIGHTQUEEN (Vinod Shinde) ran detached from the field. Trainer Mr. Azhar Ali was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

Jockey Neeraj Rawal, the rider of FAITH OF SUCCESS was fined Rs.3,000/for not improving his position from the 1000 Metres till about 500 Metres for no apparent reason.

FAITH OF SUCCESS (Neeraj Rawal) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b f ANTIBES.

<u>4th Race: 71. The Prince Ardent Trophy - (About) 1200 metres.</u> <u>Horses rated 40 to 65, 4 years old and over (9 Runners).</u>

MUSTERION (Kiran Rai P) reared up as the gates opened and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Aravind G. was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey L. Alex Rozario, the rider of KVASIR was fined Rs.2,000/- for not improving his position between the 900 Metres and 600 Metres for no apparent reason.

WATCHMYSTARS (P. S. Chouhan) sustained gum injury.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g PRICELESS GOLD.

5th Race: 72. The Tungabhadra Plate - Div. II - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 4 years old and over (10 Runners).

Jockey B. Nayak, the rider of PALM READER was fined Rs.1,000/- for shifting 'in' and causing interference to HITOMI SAKUMA (Rajesh Kumar M) on his inside approaching 350 Metres.

FLAMING ORANGE (Arvind Kumar. N) sustained injury on lower jaw.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g FOUR WHEEL DRIVE.

6th Race: 73. The Tungabhadra Plate - Div. I - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 4 years old and over (9 Runners).

ARLETTE (Akshay Kumar) ran detached from the field. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination. On examination, it was found to have pulled up lame on left hind due to clip over tendon. Trainer Mr. S.S. Attaollahi was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Jockey Kiran Rai P, the rider of CLASSIC CHARM was fined Rs.1,000/- for coming 'in' and causing interfernce to the horses on his inside viz; DEFINITIVE (Siddaraju.P) and EXCLUSIVE MANDATE (Nazerul Alam) passing the 1300 Metres.

It was observed that CLASSIC CHARM (Kiran Rai P) clipped the heels of the front runner ARLETTE (Akshay Kumar) passing the 1000 Metres.

Jockey Chethan Kalay S., the rider of MEMORITER was fined Rs.3,000/- for the excessive use of whip on his mount during the race (1st infringement).

CLASSIC CHARM (Kiran Rai P) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g GARAMOND.
