GOING: Soft

PENETROMETER READING: 4.6 Cms.

RAILING POSITION: Railing fixed at average width of 2.5 Meters

from 1600 Meters to winning post from its original position.

1st Race: 23. The Malaprabha Plate - Div. I - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over (7 Runners).

Permission was granted to Trainer Mr.Mahmood Khan to withdraw STARRY WIND (Md.Akram) on veterinary grounds as it was found to have swelling on right fore cellulitis. He was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Jockey Mohammed Aliyar, the rider of DEBONAIR was severely reprimanded for not wearing goggles at the start of race. However, it was observed that he managed to pull it down approaching 900 Metres.

Trainer Mr. Pradeep Annaiah and Jockey A.R.Pradeep were questioned with regards to the running and riding of AIR BLAST. The trainer stated that he had instructed the jockey to ride from the forward position and do his best in the straight. The Jockey while corroborating the statement of the trainer added that his mount took a fly jump as such he could not adhere to the trainer instructions. However, he did his best but could only finish third. Their explanations were noted for future reference. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination. On examination, it was found to have sustained superficial injury on right hind fetlock.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from b g AIR BLAST.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g SMITHSONIAN.

2nd Race: 24. The Linganamakki Plate - (About) 1800 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45 (8 Runners).

As Jockey S. John was certified medically unfit to ride. Permission was granted to trainer Mr. Imtiaz Khan to substitute Jockey Darshan R.N to ride PELUCHE in place of the declared rider.

WORLDLY WISE (P. S. Chouhan) planted, lost many lengths and ran detached from 300 Metres. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Darius R. Byramji was informed not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

Jockey Rayan Ahmed R., the rider of BRUCE ALMIGHTY was reprimanded for repeatedly changing the course between the 700 Metres and 500 Metres.

Jockey Neeraj Rawal, the rider of STELLAR GOLD reported his mount was lugging 'in' under pressure in the final 200 Metres of the race.

BRUCE ALMIGHTY (Rayan Ahmed R.) sustained superficial injury on right fore fetlock.

TIGNANELLO (Antony Raj S.) sutained superficial clip injury on right hind tendon.

WORLDLY WISE (P. S. Chouhan) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g TIGNANELLO.

3rd Race: 25. The Ardent Knight Trophy - (About) 1200 metres. Maiden Horses 2 years old only. (5 Runners).

Permission was granted to Trainer Mr.S. Ganapathy to withdraw BOURBON BAY on veterinary grounds as it was found to be have moist eczematous dermatitis and allergy. He was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b g CAT WHISKERS.

4th Race: 26. The Bangalore Turf Club Trophy (Grade III) - (About) 1200 metres. 3 years old and over. (4 Runners).

KENSINGTON COURT (P. Trevor) took a fly jump.

It was reported after the race that GOLDEN GUEST (Antony Raj S.) burst its blood vessels (Endoscopy - Grade IV), ILH Paralysis (Grade - IV) and also sustained superficial injury on tongue. Trainer Mr.Darius R. Byramji (deputizing on behalf of Trainer Mrs. Parvati Byramji) was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Compulsory urine and blood samples were taken for analysis from the following I,II & III placed horses viz:

5th Race: 27. The Wolf 777 Bangalore 1000 Guineas (Grade II) - (About) 1600 metres. 3-year-old Indian Fillies (foaled in 2019) (8 Runners).

Jockey Suraj Narredu, the rider of TRIPLE WISH reported that his mount was hanging 'in' straight from the 300 Metres. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Compulsory urine and blood samples were taken for analysis from the following I,II & III placed horses viz:

b f MIRRA III

6th Race: 28. The Premium Spirit Stakes - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 60 to 85 (7 Runners).

RULING GODDESS (Shreyas Singh S) accidentally brushed the running rails passing the 400 Metres.

Jockey P. Trevor, the rider of WATCHMYSTARS reported that his mount was not striding out well in the final 200 Metres of the race. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g IMPERIAL BLUE.

7th Race: 29. The Malaprabha Plate - Div. II - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over (8 Runners).

It was observed that AEROSPEED (Tousif Khan) pulled up lame before passing the winning post and as such the rider dismounted.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g CHAIN OF THOUGHTS.

Permission was granted to trainers M/s. Darius R. Byramji and S. Narredu to deputize on behalf of trainers M/s. Parvati Byramji and Rajesh Narredu who were unable to attend the races.
