RAILING POSITION: Railing fixed at its original position.

<u>1st Race: 173. The Infinite Stakes - (About) 1200 metres. Maiden Horses 3 years old only. (11 Runners).</u>

IMPERADOR (P. Trevor) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Neil B. Devaney (deputizing on behalf of Trainer Mr.Prasanna Kumar) was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

STALINGRAD (Arvind Kumar. N) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Irfan Ghatala was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

THE COMMANDER (K.G. Likith Appu) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. S. Dominic was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

ASSURANCES (Vinod Shinde) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Rajesh Narredu was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey Rajesh Kumar M, the rider of RANSOMWARE shifted 'in' caused severe interference to the horses on his inside viz; POLE STAR (Vivek.G), KONKRAH (A. Sandesh) and APHELION (Salman Khan) before passing the red marker post. *An enquiry is being held into the manner of riding of Jockey Rajesh Kumar. M.*

Jockey Salman Khan, the rider of APHELION reported that he lost his left stirrup passing the 1100 Metres, which he regained at about 550 Metres.

Jockey Arvind Kumar. N, the rider of STALINGRAD reported that his mount was not galloping fluently throughout the race and ran detached from the field. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination. On examination, it was found to be lame on left fore. Trainer Mr. Irfan Ghatala was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

It was observed that the right rein of KONKRAH (A. Sandesh) had come off during the race approaching 700 Metres as such the rider could not offer any assistance thereafter. After due examination of the equipment, it was found to be in an unserviceable condition. Hence, Jockey A. Sandesh was fined Rs.2,000/-.

Jockey P. Trevor, the rider of IMPERADOR was questioned with regard to the riding on his mount in the above race. He stated that he was instructed to ride from a forward position and do his best in the straight which he followed. He also added that his mount had nothing left in it in the final 100 Metres of the race. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. His explanations were noted for future reference.

POLE STAR (Vivek.G) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

ASSURANCES (Vinod Shinde) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from b c IMPERADOR.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g POLE STAR.

2nd Race: 174. The Press Reporters Cup - Div. II - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over (11 Runners).

Trainer Mr. Imtiaz Khan was fined Rs.5,000/- for discrepancy in shoeing in respect of his charge ANCHORAGE (C.A.Brisson) (1st infringement).

QUICK WITTED (Rajesh Kumar M) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Neil B Devaney was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

AKASI (Shreyas Singh S) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. S.Shoban Babu was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

MULTISIDED (A.R.Pradeep) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Darius R. Byramji was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey A. Prakash, the rider of SOUTHERNARISTOCRAT reported that his mount slowed down from the 1000 Metres and thereafter it was was not striding out well as such he stopped riding out his mount from 900 Metres and did not finish the course. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

It was observed that Jockey Aleemuddin, the rider of EMERALDO lost his left rein momentarily approaching 300 Metres.

Jockey Akshay Kumar, the rider of SUPERHERO was fined Rs.2,000/- for dropping hands in the final 200 Metres.

Jockey Shreyas Singh S, the rider of AKASI was fined Rs.3,000/- for the excessive use of the whip on his mount during the race (1st infringement).

It was reported after the race that TREASURE CHEST (P. Trevor) returned bleeding from both nostrils. Trainer Mr.S. Dominic was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner dk b/br g TREASURE CHEST.

<u>3rd Race: 175. The Champion Jockey Trophy - Div. II - (About) 1400</u> metres. Horses rated 20 to 45 (12 Runners).

MAJESTICMERLIN (G. Praveen) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Kishan Thomas. was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey Suhas. K, the rider of VICTORIARAYA was fined Rs.1,000/- for shifting 'in' and causing interference to ABSOLUTE KATRINA (K.G. Likith Appu) on his inside at the start.

EQUALIZER (Salman Khan) jumped awkwardly outwards onto MERICLE BEAUTY (A.R.Pradeep) soon after the start.

Jockey Laxman Singh, the rider of HIGHLAND DREAM was reprimanded for shifting out and inconveniencing MERICLE BEAUTY (A.R.Pradeep) on his outside approaching 1100 Metres.

Jockey V.R.Jagadeesh, the rider of N R I VICTORY was reprimanded for shifting 'in' and inconveniencing JULLY (Shreyas Singh S) on his inside passing the 900 Metres.

Jockey Neeraj Rawal, the rider of STAR HONOUR reported that his mount accidentally stumbled passing the 600 Metres.

Jockey A.R.Pradeep, the rider of MERICLE BEAUTY reported that his mount was not galloping fluently throughout the race. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

MAJESTICMERLIN (G. Praveen) ran detached from the field. Trainer Mr. Kishan Thomas. K was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

GLOWING MOONLIGHTS (Arvind Kumar. N) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

STAR HONOUR (Neeraj Rawal) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f N R I VICTORY.

4th Race: 176. The Press Reporters Cup - Div. I - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over (10 Runners).

DOUBLE VISION (Neeraj Rawal) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.S.Shoban Babu was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in a jump out on a starting gate practice day.

Jockey Darshan R.N, the rider of HONOURABLE LADY was fined Rs.5,000/- for the excessive use of the whip on his mount during the race (2nd infringement).

THEWHISPERQUIETLY (Aleemuddin) was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from b g THEWHISPERQUIETLY.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ch m MYSTICAL AIR.

5th Race: 177. The Champion Trainer Trophy - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 40 to 65, 5 years old and over (12 Runners).

It was observed that Jockey P. Trevor, the rider of DUFY had to steady his mount approaching 1200 Metres due to the crowding of the field.

Jockey Akshay Kumar, the rider of AQUAMATIC reported that his mount was not galloping fluently during the race. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

It was reported after the race that PROPHECY (A. Sandesh) pulled up lame on left fore. Trainer Mr. S. Padmanabhan was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

DUFY (P. Trevor) sustained clip injury on left hind fetlock.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g ALL ATTRACTION.

6th Race: 178. The Leading Stud Trophy - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 40 to 65 (10 Runners).

KLIMT (Koshi Kumar) was examined at the starting gate by the Club's Veterinary Officer and was found to be trotting lame on right fore. Under the circumstances, it was permitted to be withdrawn on veterinary grounds before coming under Starter's order. Trainer Mr. Pradeep Annaiah was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

DR ASH (Rajesh Kumar M) planted and did not raise a fluent gallop for the first 100 Metres. In view of its repeated behaviour, Trainer Mr. G. Y. Rajesh Babu was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least two Mock Races.

Jockey K.G. Likith Appu, the rider of SIRA was fined Rs.5,000/- for shifting out and causing severe interference to the horses on his outside viz; POSITIVITY (Vinod Shinde) and AHERNE (Darshan R.N) at the start.

Jockey Shreyas Singh S, the rider of AGERA was fined Rs.5,000/- for the excessive use of the whip on his mount during the race (2nd infringement).

Jockey V.R. Jagadeesh, the rider of N R I TOUCH reported that his mount was not galloping fluently during the race. The horse was subjected to veterinary examination, on examination it was found to have burst its blood vessels (on Endoscopy - Grade III). Trainer Mr. Md Sajid Qureshi was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

It was reported after the race that KNOTTY ONE (Vivek.G) returned bleeding from both nostrils. Trainer Mr. Neil B. Devaney (deputizing on behalf of Trainer Mr.Prasanna Kumar) was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

It was reported after the race that SIRA (K.G. Likith Appu) pulled up lame on right fore. Trainer Mr. M. Eshwer was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

LADYLION (Arvind Kumar. N) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b f N R I ACE.

7th Race: 179. The Leading Owner Trophy - (About) 1600 metres. Horses rated 60 to 85 (7 Runners).

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g ELPENOR.

8th Race: 180. The Governor's Trophy - (About) 1600 metres. 3-year-old horses(foaled in 2022). (4 Runners).

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g GOLD EMPIRE.

<u>9th Race: 181. The Champion Jockey Trophy - Div. I - (About) 1400 metres.</u> <u>Horses rated 20 to 45 (12 Runners).</u>

Jockey Shreyas Singh S replaced the indisposed Jockey Arvind Kumar. N on MARTINO.

WAR TRAIL (R. Robert) ran detached from the field. Trainer Mr. S.Shoban Babu was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

It was reported after the race that DESERT GODDESS (A. Sandesh) pulled up lame on left fore. Trainer Mr.S. Padmanabhan was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

PERIDOT (A.Ramu) was subjected to veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

An enquiry is being held into the running and riding of PRICELESS PRINCE, trained by Mr. Rajesh Narredu (deputizing on behalf of Trainer Mr. S. Narredu) and ridden by Jockey Hemant Chandragiri in the above race.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g CONNECTING DOTS.

<u>10th Race: 182. The Good-bye Cup - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 00 to 25(Whips not allowed) (12 Runners).</u>

SACRED CREATOR (Harish B.) was slowly away and lost many lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr.Narayana Gowda V. was informed not to accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in at least one Mock Race.

It was observed that MEGHANN (Laxman Singh) accidentally stumbled at the start.

It was observed that EMPRESS BELLA (A. Prakash) accidentally stumbled approaching 600 Metres.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner b m CHINKY PINKY.

Permission was granted to trainers M/s. Azhar Ali, Neil B. Devaney, Md Sajid Qureshi and Rajesh Narredu to deputize on behalf of trainers M/s. S.S. Attaolalhi, Prasanna Kumar, Umar Shariff. S and S. Narredu who were unable to attend the races.
