### **Press Conference BSM - 2012**

### **PRESS CONFERENCE**

Gentlemen,

On behalf of the Members of the Managing Committee of the Bangalore Turf Club Ltd., I have great pleasure in extending a warm welcome to all of you to this Press Conference.

- I. The Bangalore Summer Meeting 2012 will commence on Saturday, 19<sup>th</sup> May 2012 and will conclude on Friday, 10th August 2012. Racing will be conducted over 26 days during the Meeting. Racing will be held on Saturdays and Sundays except during the last two weeks. Concurrently, Summer Races are being held at Mysore spread over 15 days during the period between 24<sup>th</sup> May and 30<sup>th</sup> July 2012, mainly on Wednesdays.
  - (a) Details of professionals expected to participate in the ensuing season are as under:

(c) About 925 racing horses including 94 outstation horses are stabled in the BTC premises and about 800 horses are expected to participate during the meeting as against 768 during the previous summer meeting.

(b) Stake Money has been increased by 7.5% in respect of all ordinary races as detailed below, as compared to last Winter Meeting.

- (c) Added Money for all the Sweepstake Races has been increased by 20%, as compared to Bangalore Summer Meeting 2011.
- (d) Added Money for the Bangalore City Gold Cup (Grade III) has been increased to Rs. 12.00 lakhs, as compared to Rs. 5.00 lakhs during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2011.
- (e) Value of Trophies has been increased to a minimum of Rs. 25,000/-, as compared to Rs. 10,000/- during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2011.

## III. <u>INCENTIVES:</u>

(a) The existing level of Performance Linked Incentives to owners has been enhanced by 32%, as compared to Bangalore Winter Meeting 2011-12:

Winner Rs. 26,400 : : Second Rs. 13,200 Third Rs. 6,600 Fourth : Rs. 3,960 Fifth Rs. 2,640 : Rs. 1,320 Sixth

- (b) Payment of incentives on stakes earned by local horses in ordinary races, during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2012 has been enhanced to 15% as compared to 10% paid last year.
- (c) Payment of 10% incentive on stakes won by local horses bred in Karnataka will continue as in winter meeting 2011-12.
- (d) Payment of 20% incentive on stakes earned by local horses in ordinary races will continue on the same basis, as during the last winter meeting, in respect of owners not having interest in more than 5 horses.
- (e) Value of Trophy would be paid to the winner/s in respect of lower divisions from the ensuing Summer Meeting, as compared to the earlier practice of presenting Trophies for divisions.
- (f) Estimated total outlay for the season would be Rs. 18.00 crores over 26 days covering stakes and incentives as compared to Rs. 15.40 crores paid during last summer over 26 days.

# **IV. OUTSTATION HORSES:**

The following category of horses alone are eligible for allotment of stables in order of priority subject to the availability of stables:

(a) All 3 and 4 year olds that are entered for Bangalore Summer Classic 2012 and not struck out till the commencement of Bangalore Summer Meeting 2012.

- (b) 3-year-olds that are entered for at least FIVE Sweepstakes races to be run during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2012.
- (c) 3-year-olds which have won at least one race.
- (d) 4 year olds rated 60 and above & 5, 6, 7 tears rated 80 and above.

However, outstation horses will not be permitted to participate in races earmarked for horses rated 00 to 25.

## V. **SPONSORSHIP:**

- (a) THE KINGFISHER DERBY BANGALORE (GRADE I) will be sponsored as in last summer, with added money of Rs. 100 lakhs, inclusive of the Club's contribution of Rs. 50.00 lakhs, and an equal contribution of Rs. 50.00 lakhs by the sponsors.
- (b) The total stakes for this race is expected to be in excess of Rs.2.00 crores and it will be the second richest race in the year 2012, next only to Indian Derby
- (c) The Club guarantees stakes of Rs. 1.00 crore to the winner in the above race.
- (d) The added money for the Fillies Championship Stakes (Grade I) and the Colts Championship Stakes(Grade I) will be Rs. 25.00 lakhs each as during last Summer Meeting and efforts are being made to secure sponsorship for these races.
- (e) THE NANOLI STUD JUVENILE MILLION (GRADE II), carrying an added money of Rs. 12.00 lakhs, plus Trophy value Rs. 60,000/-, inclusive of the Club's contribution of Rs. 6.30 lakhs, will be sponsored by M/s. NANOLI STUD FARM.
- (f) THE NOVOTEL MAHARAJA'S CUP (Grade II) carrying added money of Rs. 18.00 lakhs plus Trophy valued at Rs. 1.00 lakh will be sponsored by NOVOTEL BENGALURU TECH PARK with a contribution of Rs. 9.50 lakhs, with the Club contributing an equal amount.

#### VI. **GENERAL**:

(a) The norms earlier in force in respect of Jockeys will be valid for the year 2012-13. Norms for granting licenses to Trainers have been

revised with effect from 16<sup>th</sup> May 2012 and the following represents the changes effected for the year 2012-13:

- (1) To grant a maximum period of 120 days or up till the date of renewal of license, whichever is later, for recouping the strength of horses, in the event of the number of horses under a trainer falling below the minimum stipulated number of five horses.
- (2) To restrict the number of licenses to Trainers ('A' License) at:
  - (i) Bangalore to a maximum of 40 with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2012;
  - (ii) New licenses will be granted only with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2012; and
  - (iii) Mysore to a maximum of 21 and to further reduce to 20.
- (3) To limit the number of racing horses per trainer at Bangalore to a maximum of **forty five** at any given point of time during the period of license **with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2012** in respect of Bangalore based trainers, with a restriction that the maximum number of racing horses in any age group would not exceed **sixteen with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2012.**
- (4) To limit the number of non-racing two-year-olds to a maximum of **sixteen** in respect of Bangalore based trainers with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2012.
- (b) From 27<sup>th</sup> April 2012 till date, the Club has received rain fall of 4½". The race track is in good condition and the 'going' as of now is good.
- (c) With a view to enhancing the video coverage of running of races, following action has been taken:
  - (1) Two additional cameras have been installed at 1600 and 550 metre markers.
  - (2) Three cameras have been re-positioned at 900, 650 and 400 metre markers.
- (d) 485 betting terminals are currently in operation, including 103 betting terminals being operated at off-course betting centres. Additional 50 new betting terminals will be installed by 10<sup>th</sup> June 2012.
- (e) Rating book has been published as during the previous years.
