On behalf of the Members of the Managing Committee of the Bangalore Turf Club Ltd., I have great pleasure in extending a warm welcome to all of you to this Press Conference.

- I. The Bangalore Summer Meeting 2015 will commence on Saturday, 16th May 2015 and will conclude on Friday, 7th August 2015. Racing will be conducted over 26 days during the Meeting. Racing will be held on Saturdays and Sundays except during the last two weeks.

III. GRADED/CLASSIC RACES AND SPONSORSHIP:

(a) Added money and the guaranteed stakes for the classic races to be run during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2015 has been increased as detailed below:

- (b) THE KINGFISHER DERBY BANGALORE (GRADE I) will be sponsored as in last summer, with guarantee money of Rs. 250 lakhs, inclusive of the Club's contribution of Rs. 70.00 lakhs, and an equal contribution of Rs. 70.00 lakhs by the sponsors. It will be the second richest race in the year 2015, next only to Indian Derby.
- (c) The added money for the Fillies Championship Stakes (Grade I) and the Colts Championship Stakes (Grade I) will be Rs. 50.00 lakhs each. These races are expected to garner total stakes in excess of Rs. 75.00 lakhs each.
- (d) The Club is making efforts to source new sponsors.
- (e) The BANGALORE ST. LEGER (Grade II) confined to four year old horses all these years, will now be open to horses four years old and over from the year 2016.

IV. STAKE MONEY FOR ORDINARY RACES:

- (a) Stakes will be allocated in the ratio of 82.5%, 10% and 7.5% in favour of Owners, Trainers and Jockeys respectively for Bangalore Summer Meeting 2015, including sweepstake races, in lieu of the ratio of 79%, 12% and 9% respectively for Owners, Trainers and Jockeys during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2014.
- (b) Level of stake money has been increased by 3.7%, as compared to Bangalore Winter Meeting 2014-15 in respect of all ordinary races.

(c) Stakes in ordinary races had been restructured in the ratio 100:50:30:12.5:6.25:3.125, as compared to 100:50:25:15:10:5, which was in vogue till Bangalore Winter Meeting 2014-15, with more weightage being given to third placed horses.

(a) Performance linked incentives in respect of Bangalore based horses has been increased by 5.5%, as detailed under, compared to the previous year:

- (b) 10% incentive would continue to be paid on 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th stakes earned in ordinary races during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2015 in respect of horses bred in Karnataka, as during the previous year.
- (c) 20% incentive would continue to be paid on 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th stakes earned in ordinary races during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2015 and it will be credited on a pro-rata basis to the concerned Owner/s of local horses, provided such Owner/s has/have no interest in more than five local horses excluding 2-year-olds (Foaled in 2013) owned either individually and/or jointly and/or by a syndicate, as during the previous year.
- (d) Additional incentive (summer incentive) of 15% on 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th stakes earned in ordinary races during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2015 will be credited to the respective Owners Accounts in respect of local horses, as during the previous year.

VIII. TOTAL PAYOUT:

It is expected that pay out during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2015 would be around Rs. 20.88 crores for 220 races, covering 26 race days, as compared to Rs. 19.59 crores during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2014 for 200 races, covering 25 race days.

IX. STABLING:

- (a) Under the local category, horses aged 3 to 8 years rated 00 and above will be eligible for allotment of stables.
- (b) Restriction has also been placed in respect of NON-PARTICIPATING AND NON-PERFORMING HORSES to the following effect:

"Horses aged 4 years old and over which have not raced since 1st May 2014 and horses aged 4 years old and over which have not placed First, Second, Third or Fourth in their last ten starts will not be permitted to participate in Bangalore Summer Meeting 2015. However, if the Owner/s of such horses prefer to race such horses, a service charge of Rs. 25,000/- per horse will be levied."

- (c) The following category of outstation horses will be eligible for allotment of stables for Bangalore Summer Meeting 2015, with deposit of Rs. 20,000/- hitherto charged having been waived:
 - (1) All 3 and 4 year olds that are entered for Bangalore Summer Classics 2015 and not struck out till the date of stable allotment.
 - (2) 3 and 4 year olds that are entered for at least THREE Sweepstake Races to be run during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2015.
 - (3) Horses aged 3 to 8 years rated above 65.
- (d) Outstation horses will not be permitted to participate in races earmarked for horses rated 00 to 25.
- (e) Outstation horses aged 3 years and horses aged 4 to 6 years rated 50 and above will be entitled for permanent stabling under the charge of `A' licensed Trainers, subject to certain conditions, on the line permitted during the Bangalore Winter Meeting 2014-15.
- (f) However, service charges for non-participation in respect of outstation horses has been made more stringent to the effect that in case a horse fails to complete three runs, service charges as detailed below will be debited to the account of the Owner concerned:

(1) If the horse does not race at all - Rs. 50,000/-

(2) If the horse runs once - Rs. 25,000/-

(3) If the horse runs twice - Rs. 12,500/-

XI. GENERAL:

- (a) Following the hearing of the Special Leave Petitions filed by the Bangalore Turf Club Ltd. and the Karnataka Racehorse Owners Association in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in matters pertaining to the tenure of the existing Racecourse on 25th March 2015, leave has been granted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter.
- (b) Revised Rules governing Medication and Treatment of Horses in Training and Racing have been notified, so as to be effective from 16th May 2015.
- (c) Alongside, revised Rules have been published in regard to use of Anabolic Steroids and Sex Hormones, so as to be effective from 16th May 2015.
- (d) The following qualifying conditions have been stipulated in the norms for licensing Trainers to be in force for the period 1st May 2015 to 31st March 2018:
 - (1) Total number of placed horses (1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th) shall be equivalent to at least 75% of the total strength of number of horses under the charge of a Trainer (average of 12 months / period of license).
 - (2) Total number of wins shall be equivalent to at least 20% of the total strength of number of horses under the charge of a Trainer (average of 12 months / period of license).
- (e) The existing qualifying conditions in respect of licensing Jockeys will continue to be in force for the period 1st May 2015 to 31st March 2018:
 - (1) A Jockey should have ridden at least in twenty races during the previous year i.e. from 1st April to 31st March.
 - (2) A Jockey should have ridden at least three horses, which have placed first, second or third during the above said period.
- (f) With seeding of new grass in progress, the movable railings would be gradually shifted out from 1600 metres up till 5 metres at the 1000 metres.
- (g) Live streaming services would be on pay per view mode of broadcasting with effect from 23rd May 2015 on advance payment of Rs. 4,500/- per annum.
- (h) A giant video screen would be in operation on all Bangalore Race Days.
- (i) 630 betting terminals are currently in operation, including 120 betting terminals being operated at nine off-course betting centres.
- (j) Rating book has been published as in the past.
- (k) 18 Bookmakers will be in operation in the First Enclosure.
