PRESS CONFERENCE

Gentlemen,

On behalf of the Members of the Managing Committee of the Bangalore Turf Club Ltd., I have great pleasure in extending a warm welcome to all of you to this Press Conference.

At the very outset, we would like to thank the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Karnataka and the Addl. Chief Secretary and the Finance Commissioner of the Government of Karnataka for their gracious support in sanctioning license to conduct racing at Bangalore from 5th January, 2018

Bangalore Winter Meeting 2017-2018, comprising 15 race days, is scheduled to commence on Saturday, 6th January, 2018 and conclude on Friday, 16th March 2018. Racing will be held mainly on Fridays and Saturdays. The Bangalore Derby (Grade I) is scheduled to be run on Sunday, 11th February, 2018.

PROFESSIONALS:

- (a) 78 Jockeys including 17 jockeys claiming allowance and 1 foreign jockey namely David Allan, have been issued `A' license and 72 Jockeys including 17 jockeys claiming allowance have been issued `B' license. In all, 150 jockeys have been issued license during the year 2017-18 and about 100 jockeys are expected to ride during the Winter Meeting.
- (b) 37 "A" licensed trainers are expected to take part in the Meeting. In addition, many 'B' licensed trainers are expected to run their wards in Graded and Classic races.

- (a) 15 Stables have been earmarked for allotment on a permanent basis to the following category of outstation horses to participate in Bangalore Races:
 - (1) Horses aged 4 years.
- (2) Horses aged 5 to 7 years rated 50 and above under B.T.C Rules of racing.

SALIENT FEATURES:

- (a) Number of races will be restricted to a maximum of seven on all race days at the option of the Stewards.
- (b) Minimum number of acceptors has been retained at 6 with respect to races to be run over a distance of 1600 meters and more and in respect of races for horses rated 75 and above.
- (c) Maximum number of acceptors in respect of ordinary races will continue to be 12 except the first four days and the Oaks and the Derby Day where the maximum number of runners will be 14.
- (d) Five races including three races for Indian Jockeys claiming allowance have been reserved prohibiting the use of whip.

GENERAL:

- (a) Jockeys will continue to be subjected to a breath analyzer test on every race day for detecting the presence of alcohol.
- (b) A maximum of 690 betting terminals will be in operation, including 85 betting terminals at off-course betting centres located outside the racecourse.
