HISTORY OF BANGALORE TURF CLUB LTD

Horse Racing as a tradition in Bangalore dates back over a century when the French and the British arrived in India in the 1800s, they all noted that Bangalore had a natural climate for raising finer horses due to Bangalore's year-round temperatures that average between 15 and 30 degrees Celsius at that time.

First it was at Agram Race Course in Domlur in the year 1842 and relocated to the existing premises in the year 1863 which was granted by the Maharaja of Mysuru for the purpose of horse racing as long as the Bangalore Turf Club wanted it – provided it was only used as a race course.

The Bangalore Turf Club and the racecourse was built in the year 1923.



The first ever Bangalore Summer Derby was run in 1962. Since its inception, it has seen a myriad of successful editions celebrating the best of horse racing and fashion in India.

Summer in India is often full of humid days that are not suited for horse racing. Hence, Bangalore stands out as a singular city during this season where Trainers from all over India meet, race, and stable their horses all summer long on the lush 70 acres of BTC [earlier it was 85 acres].

One of the main reasons that the Bangalore Derby and its racecourse rose to greatness is due to the unique U-shape of the track. At 1950 metres, there are four sharp curves and uphill gradients that make it challenging, and one of the most competitive races in India. Therefore, if you are determining the tenacity of a horse or jockey, passing the Bangalore Derby test is a must.

PRIZE MONEY

We are pleased to inform that the aggregate total prize money earmarked for the Bangalore Summer Meeting 2022 is **Rs 14.41 crores** and the category-wise prize money is as shown below:

Total value of trophies is **Rs 19,80,000/-**.

An average 21% increase in prize money across all categories of races compared to Bangalore Winter Meeting 2021-2022.

Trophy value has been increased from Rs 50,000/- to Rs 60,000/- for the races of horses rated 80 & above and from Rs 25,000/- to Rs 35,000/- for all the other handicap races.

Trophy value has been enhanced from Rs 1,25,000/- to Rs 1,75,000/- for both Fillies' and Colts' Championship Stakes. Similarly, for St. Leger, it has been enhanced from Rs 80,000/- to Rs 1,35,000/-.

SALIENT FEATURES

- 30% of the races are opened to outstation horses in the category of 40-65 and maiden races.
- As usual, outstation horses are eligible to participate in the categories of 60-85 and 80 & above besides Classics and Sweepstakes Races.
- Minimum number of acceptors are 4 with respect to races to be run over a distance of 1800 metres or more and 5 with respect to races for the category of 80 and above and 6 with respect to races for the category of 60-85.
- Maximum number of acceptors in respect of ordinary races will continue to be 12 except the classic race days where the maximum number of runners will be 14.

GENERAL

- Jockeys will continue to be subjected to breathalysers on every race day for detecting the presence of alcohol.
- It was decided to test both Blood & Urine Samples in respect of the first three placed horses in the graded races.
- Urine or Blood Sample will be collected compulsorily from the winner of all races.



THE FILLIES' CHAMPIONSHIP STAKES, Gr.1

The first classic of the season, the Fillies' Championship Stakes, **Gr.1** [About 1600 metres race for 3-year-old Indian fillies] will be held on **Sunday**, **19**th **June**, **2022** and the guaranteed prize money advertised is Rs 50 lakhs and value of trophies is Rs 1.75 lakhs.

The probable top contenders would be:

KING'S RANSOM – ran 2nd in the Breeders' Juvenile Fillies' Championship, **Gr.3**, FAITH winner of two races from the yard of Trainer P. Shroff [RWITC]. QUEEN SPIRIT – ran 3rd in the Nilgiris 1000 Guineas, **Gr.3**, SHABELLE – ran 3rd in the Breeders' Produce Stakes, **Gr.3** from the yard of Trainer S.S. Attaollahi [BTC]. SPEAKING OF LOVE finished 3rd in the Alcock Arabian Million, **Gr.3** from the stables of Trainer L.D. Silva [HRC].

THE MAHARAJA'S GOLD CUP, Gr.2

The iconic Maharaja's Gold Cup, **Gr.2** [About 2200 metres race for Indian 4-year-olds & over] is scheduled on **Sunday, 10th July, 2022**. The advertised guaranteed prize money is Rs 50 lakhs. **Mr Zavaray S. Poonawalla** will be co-sponsoring 'The Maharaja's Gold Cup. **Gr.2**' by contributing a sum of Rs 15 lakhs towards the prize money and Rs 50,000/- towards the Trophy Value. At the stage of closure of first entries, 27 horses have been entered which includes:

THE BANGALORE SUMMER DERBY, Gr.1

The blue riband of the season Bangalore Summer Derby, **Gr.1** [About 2000 metres race for Indian 3-year-olds] is scheduled on **Sunday**, **17**th **July**, **2022**. The advertised guaranteed prize money is Rs 200 lakhs and value of trophies is Rs 3 lakhs.

We must place on record our deep sense of gratitude and special thanks to **Dr Vijay Mallya**, former Chairman of the UB Group who took the initiative and sponsored the Bangalore Summer Derby for the last 34 editions uninterruptedly and brought glitz and glamour to the sport because of which the Bangalore Summer Derby reached greater heights and became one of the most exciting events in the Indian Racing Calendar.

The top finishers of the Fillies' and Colts' Championships will be fighting out for the coveted post.



THE BANGALORE ST. LEGER, Gr.2

The last classic of the season, the Bangalore St. Leger, **Gr.2** [About 2800 metres race for Indian 4-year-olds & over] is scheduled on **Sunday**, **24**th **July**, **2022**.

The probable top contenders would be:

ALICIA, CHOPIN, PARISIAN and ZUCCARELLI from the stables of Trainer P. Shroff [RWITC], APSARA STAR from the stables of James Mckeown [MRC], MY OPINION of Trainer B. Suresh [MRC], FIRE POWER of Trainer L.V.R. Deshmukh [HRC], POINT TO PROVE of Trainer Arjun Mangalorkar [BTC] and SOUTHERN DYNASTY of Trainer S. Ganapathy [BTC].

CONCLUDING DAY

The Governor's Cup, **Gr.3** [a longer distance race of about 2400 metres for Indian 4-year-olds & over] is scheduled on the last day of the season i.e. **Friday**, **5**th **August**, **2022**. As per the convention, the Hon'ble Governor of the Karnataka State shall be witnessing the event and giving away the Trophies to the winning connections.



PROFESSIONALS

- 28 'A' licensed Trainers are expected to take part in the Bangalore Summer Meeting 2022. Similarly, 14 'B' licensed Trainers from other centres are also expected to participate.
- 70 Jockeys including 12 Jockeys claiming allowance have been issued 'A' License and 30 Jockeys have been issued 'B' License. In all, about 112 Jockeys are expected to participate during the Bangalore Summer Meeting 2022.

OUTSTATION CHAMPIONS

71 horses from the stables of 14 Trainers across the country have come down to BTC to participate in the Bangalore Summer Meeting 2022 to vie for honours. Out of which, there are 46 3-year-olds and 9 each of 4 and 5-year-olds which is an indication that the field is going to be more competitive and exciting. To name a few, the champion outstation horses that have created a buzz by coming down to Bangalore are ZUCCARELLI, SPEAKING OF LOVE, ARCANA, DEXA, DISRUPTOR, LEONARDO, ONCE YOU GO BLACK, SUPERNATURAL, FAITH, KING'S RANSOM, CHOPIN, JULIETTE, MIRACLE, MY OPINION, THEON and TRAFALGAR.



COMBINED TOTE OPERATIONS / COMMINGLING

In line with 'One Nation, One Tax', the Turf Authorities of India is striving hard to commence the Combined Tote Operations / Commingling amongst all the Turf Clubs in India as 'One Nation, One Tote', so as to maximize the tote revenue and enable the racing patrons to earn higher dividends. Commingling is a new trend and it has helped Turf Clubs / Jockey Clubs across the globe to multiply their revenue. When the Combined Tote Operations kick-start on 1st of July, 2022 with the help and cooperation of all the Turf Authorities, it will be a historical day in Indian racing as it would extensively benefit all the stakeholders of the sport.

Commingling is a process where one totalizator combines its wagering pool with another to create one common dividend and brings the entire racing patrons fraternity together for better experience and better dividends with identical pools and identical commission on all pools. The Turf Authorities would be well equipped to compete with Bookmakers. Not to mention, the commingling would improve transparency and accountability of betting operations.
