However, horses certified unfit for racing by the Club's Veterinary Officer during the above period will be exempted from service charges.

- Outstation horses will be allowed to participate in the following races:

OATS SUBSIDY TO "A" LICENSED TRAINERS FOR THE PERIOD

1st DECEMBER,2022 TO 31st MARCH,2023

(A) Concessions for 2-year-olds (Foaled in 2021)

 A sum of Rs. 1000 per horse per month will be credited to the account of the Trainer concerned in respect of 2-year-olds (Foaled in 2021) from 1st January, 2023 or from the date of arrival in B.T.C. premises whichever is later upto 31st October, 2023.

This subsidy will be extended to horse/s which are stabled outside the premises of Bangalore Turf Club Ltd. for whom B.T.C. could not provide stables even after such horse/s was/were registered and a request for allotment of stable/s was made by the concerned Owner/Trainer.

In case any horse/s after obtaining the subsidy fails to occupy the stable/s before 1st November, 2023, after the stable/s was duly allotted to such horse/s, a penalty equivalent to ten times the subsidy paid will be debited to the account of the Trainer concerned.

2. If any horse is taken away to any other Centre before 31st December, 2025 without completing four runs under B.T.C. Rules, the entire amount paid as Oats Subsidy by the Club will be recovered from the Trainer/Owner.

In addition a service charge will be debited to the Owner's account for the period for which the horse is stabled in the B.T.C.premises as detailed below.

i) if the horse does not run even once: Rs.5,000/- per month
ii) if the horse runs only once: Rs.2,000/- per month
iii) if the horse runs only twice: Rs.1,000/- per month

iv) if the horse runs only thrice: Rs. 500/- per month

Until the amount is fully settled the horse/s will not be permitted to leave the premises of B.T.C. Ltd.

However, horses certified unfit for racing by the Club's Veterinary Officer will be exempted from service charges, provided such horses leave B.T.C. premises not later than one month from the date of such certification.

- 3. A maximum of 225 two-year-olds will be permitted to be enrolled as local horses.
- 4. These 2-year-olds must be registered before entering the B.T.C premises.

(B) Concessions for 2/3-year-olds (Foaled in 2020) and 3 years old and over.

Oats subsidy will be credited as indicated for 2-year-olds (Foaled in 2021) above provided the horse either runs at least twice under B.T.C. Rules during the period 1st December, 2022 to 31st October, 2023 or earns prize money for any place at least once under B.T.C. Rules during the said period. However, horses certified unfit by the Club's Veterinary Officer will also be paid the above subsidy even if such horses do not complete the requisite number of runs during the above period.

In case a horse temporarily leaves the centre, subsidy will be recovered for the period of absence only, if the period extends beyond one month.

- Only horses which are under the charge of 'A' Licensed Trainers and availed of Oats Subsidy before the commencement of Bangalore Winter Meeting 2022-23 and which are stabled in B.T.C. premises before the commencement of Bangalore Winter Meeting 2022-23 are eligible for Subsidised Oats.
- 3. The number of horses which will receive Oats Subsidy will be limited at the discretion of the Management to a maximum of 1000 horses at any time during the year.

Note: Horses aged 4 years old and over which have not placed first, second, third or fourth in their last ten starts as on 1st December, 2022 will not be eligible for the above subsidy.

REG: ALLOTMENT OF STABLES TO OUTSTATION HORSES ON A PERMANENT BASIS

Trainers and Owners are hereby informed that Bangalore Turf Club Ltd., will permit the following category of horses coming from any racing centre in India for allotment of stables on a Permanent basis at Bangalore to participate in Bangalore races:-

- (i) Horses aged 3 years old.
- (ii) Horses aged 4 to 6 years rated 50 and above under B.T.C. Rules of Racing.

However, allotment of stables to these horses are subject to the following conditions:

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- All persons taking part in Bangalore Winter Meeting 2022-2023 shall be bound by the Rules of Racing of the B.T.C. and Notifications issued from time to time in the B.T.C. Racing Calendar and such regulations as may be laid down by the Stewards of the Meeting.
- 2. (a) Unless already registered under B.T.C., R.C.T.C., R.W.I.T.C., M.R.C., H.R.C. or My.R.C. Rules, horses must be registered under these rules: otherwise entries will be refused.
 - (b) Application for allotment of rating of a horse already registered must be made to the Secretary, B.T.C. Ltd. at least two days prior to the dates fixed for closing of entries for the respective race days. When applying for allotment of rating of a horse under B.T.C. Rules of Racing, the applicant must state the date on which and the centre where the horse last raced. If the horse has never raced before, the age and sex must be stated.
- (a) No horse shall be entered in any race other than those for which it is eligible unless otherwise mentioned in the conditions of the race.
 - (b) Horses which have raced at Meetings other than those conducted under the B.T.C.Rules of Racing subsequent to allotment of rating by the B.T.C. Handicapper, must be allotted the rating again by the B.T.C. Handicapper, prior to entry for Handicap races under these Rules. Entries of any horse for a Handicap race for which application for allotment of rating has not been received, may be refused or cancelled.
 - (c) In the event of a horse having raced at a Meeting other than under the B.T.C. Rules of Racing subsequent to its having been entered for a Handicap race under B.T.C. Rules, the entries of such horse will be void.
 - (d) In the event of a horse having raced at a Meeting other than under the B.T.C. Rules of Racing subsequent to having been Handicapped under B.T.C. Rules, such horse shall be withdrawn from the race even after having been Handicapped or Accepted.
- 4. Before a horse is allowed to start in a race for the first time under B.T.C. Rules of Racing, such horse must be produced before the Club's Veterinary Officer for identification. The responsibility of obtaining a copy of the Certificate of Identity rests with the Owner or Trainer concerned.

- The dates and times at which Forfeits/Scratchings are advertised to fall due are liable to alteration after the closing of entries, should circumstances arise, which in the opinion of the Stewards, make it desirable. All horses accepting i.e. 'left in' after the time fixed for final forfeits/scratchings must be declared to start unless prior permission for their withdrawal has been obtained from the Stewards. No horse shall be entered to participate in more than two races during the racing weekend (i.e from Monday to Sunday), excepting the Sweepstakes races. However, no horse shall be accepted to participate in more than one race on the same day or the following day.
 - In the event of a horse being left in for more than one race in contravention of the above rule the person responsible for it shall be fined not less than Rs.10,000/-, but the Owner of such horse shall be permitted to run such horse in any one race of his choice.
- Owners, Trainers and Jockeys should make themselves familiar with the B.T.C. Track Rules and regulations.
- 7. All the entries should be submitted via the online portal of www.bangaloreraces.com on or before the closing date and time for the entries as published in the Prospectus/Racing Programme/ Notice as notified from time to time. However, outstation Owners, Trainers, Authorised Agents may send their entries to the undersigned by Fax, Email or through any other electronic mode. If the entries are not signed by the Owner, they must be accompanied by a written authority from the Owner to the enterer, unless such authority has already been registered by B.T.C.
- 8. (a) The full advertised prize will be given in every race except in the case of a walk-over when only half the advertised prize will be given subject to the deduction as provided in clause (c) below.
 - (b) The Prize money for the second, third, fourth, fifth and sixth placed horses in whichever race these are offered will be given provided there are at least four, six, eight, ten and twelve acceptors respectively in that race. However, this rule will not apply to Sweepstakes races.
 - (c) Prize money/incentives in any race will be credited to the respective Owner/Trainer/Jockey's account, only after receipt of the analysis of the urine sample of the winner in that race coming clear of any prohibited substance.

- (d) i) 0.5% of Gross Prize money to the owners for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th places in all races will be deducted as Owners' Contribution towards the Karnataka Racehorse Owners' Association.
 - ii) 9.5% of Gross Prize money to the owners for, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th places in all races will be deducted as Owners' contribution towards The Bangalore Animal & Stable Employees' Welfare Society.
 - iii) 13.33 % of Gross Prize money to the Jockeys for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th places in all races (except in Sweepstakes and Classic/s Races) will be deducted as Jockeys' contribution in favour of Jockeys Association of India.
 - iv) 10 % of Gross Prize money to the Trainers for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th places in all races will be deducted as Trainers' contribution in favour of Karnataka Trainers Association.
 - v) An amount equivalent to 1% of Gross Prize money paid to Owners, Trainers and Jockeys for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th places in all races will be contributed to The Bangalore Animal & Stable Employees' Welfare Society by the Club.
 - vi) An amount equivalent to 1% of Gross Prize money paid to Owners, Trainers and Jockeys for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th places in ordinary races will be contributed to the Jockeys Association of India by the Club.
 - vii) An amount equivalent to 0.5% of Gross Prize money paid to Owners, Trainers and Jockeys for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th places in ordinary races will be contributed to the Karnataka Trainers Association by the Club.
 - viii) In respect of local horses,15% performance linked incentive on 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th Owner's prize money earned in all races (except in Sweepstakes & Classic/s races) will be credited to the accounts of the Owners concerned.
- (e) The prizes for lower division race/s, if any, will be the same as for the first division including the Cup/Trophy/Salver. However, the value of the Cup/Trophy/Salver will be given to the Owner/s in respect of lower divisions instead of Cup/Trophy/ Salver.

- (f) In case the Owner/s of the winner wishes to surrender the Trophy to the Club in any Cup/Trophy/Salver race excepting Sweepstake Races, 65% of the value of the Cup/Trophy/Salver will be paid. Request for such exchange should be made to the Secretary of the Club within seven days from the date of running of the relevant race.
- (g) "Any Tax Central/State, liable to be paid on Prize Money/Cup/ Trophy/Salver is included within the Prize Money/Cup/Trophy/ Salver respectively and shall be paid by the Owners/Trainers/ Jockeys/Breeders or any other persons".
- 9. (a) The Stewards reserve the right, to declare void any race in which there are less than 12 entries in bona fide separate interests.
 - (b) The number of races will be restricted to a maximum of Eight on all race days at the option of Stewards.
 - (c) Unless otherwise specified if at the time of Final Forfeits/ Scratchings there are less than FOUR acceptors (in races over a distance of 1800 Metres or more), SIX acceptors (in races for maiden horses 2 years old in 2022 & 3 years old in 2023) and FIVE acceptors (horses rated 70 & above) in a bonafied separate interests and less than EIGHT acceptors in any other race, such race or races may be declared void at the option of the Stewards.
 - (d) Unless otherwise specified if at the time of Final Forfeits/ Scratchings in a Sweepstakes race there are less than FOUR acceptors in bona fide separate interests such race or races may be declared void at the option of the Stewards.
- 10. The Stewards may arrange the entrants for any race into two or more divisions and in Handicaps adjust the weights of any division at their discretion. At the time of Final Forfeits/Scratchings the Stewards may further arrange for a race, or a division thereof to be divided on the basis of the weights published.
- 11.(a) In any race other than a sweepstakes race, if the acceptors exceed 12 but not more than 19, then the acceptors in excess of 12 will be eliminated from amongst the horses belonging to Trainer/s and Owner/s (i.e. anyone owner either individually or in a partnership) who have accepted the highest number of horses by applying one or more of the following criteria in that order:-
 - (i) Preference of elimination submitted by the Owner/Trainer, if any

- (ii) Descending order of the age of horses.
- (iii) Descending order of the number of starts of the horses during the meeting.
- (iv) Descending order of the Performance (1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th) of the horse during the meeting.
- In case of a tie, lots will be drawn.
 This process will be continued till the required number of horses are eliminated.
- (b) In respect of races for horses aged 4/5 and 6 years old and over in any category, if the acceptors exceed 12 but not more than 19, then the acceptors in excess of 12 will be eliminated from amongst the horses belonging to Trainer/s and Owner/s (i.e. anyone owner either individually or in a partnership) who have accepted the highest number of horses by applying one or more of the following criteria in that order:-
- (i) Preference of elimination submitted by the Owner/Trainer, if any
- (ii) Descending order of the number of starts of the horses during the meeting.
- (iii) Descending order of the Performance (1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th) of the horse during the meeting.
- (iv) In case of a tie, lots will be drawn.This process will be continued till the required number of horses are eliminated.
- (c) If the acceptors exceed 19 but not more than 24 the race will be divided into two divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (d) If the acceptors exceed 24 but not more than 30, then the acceptors in excess of 24 will be eliminated as per the procedure detailed above and the race will be divided into two divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (e) If the acceptors exceed 30 but not more than 36 the race will be divided into three divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (f) If the acceptors exceed 36, then the acceptors in excess of 36 will be eliminated as per the procedure detailed above and the race will be divided into three divisions at the option of the Stewards.

- (g) (i) However, the number of acceptors will be permitted up to a maximum of 14 in all ordinary races on days which the following races are run i.e
 - a) The Bangalore 1000 Guineas (Grade II)
 - b) The Bangalore 2000 Guineas (Grade II)
 - c) The Bangalore Oaks (Grade II)
 - d) The Bangalore Derby (Grade I)

If the acceptors exceed 14 but not more than 19, then the acceptors in excess of 14 will be eliminated as per the procedure detailed under clauses 11(a) & (b).

- (ii) If the acceptors exceed 19 but not more than 28 the race will be divided into two divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (iii) If the acceptors exceed 28 but not more than 36, then the acceptors in excess of 28 will be eliminated as per the procedure detailed above and the race will be divided into two divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (iv) If the acceptors exceed 36 but not more than 42 the race will be divided into three divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (v) If the acceptors exceed 42, then the acceptors in excess of 42 will be eliminated as per the procedure detailed above and the race will be divided into three divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (h) If in a Sweepstakes race, the number of acceptors exceed 18, the additional acceptors will be rejected by eliminating the horses who have earned the lowest aggregate Prize Money after 31st March, 2020. In case of a tie, rejection shall be by drawing lots. The entry money, forfeits and any other contributions in respect of the horses eliminated will be fully refunded.
- (i) Owners and Trainers who have accepted more than one horse in a race, may exercise their priority of elimination in the portal of Bangalore Turf Club Ltd., i.e. www.bangaloreraces.com before the time of scratchings for that day as published in the Prospectus/ Racing Programme/Notice as notified from time to time.
- (j) Service charges will not be levied in respect of the horses eliminated.
- (k) (i) A horse eliminated from a race shall not be excluded by elimination, when it has been accepted the next time in any race other than a sweepstakes race.

- (ii) In case a race is declared void owing to paucity of acceptors, horses who have accepted in that race would be deemed to have been eliminated from that race and such horses also shall not be excluded by elimination when they accept next time.
- (iii) In case a race is cancelled after acceptances, horses who have accepted in that race would be deemed to have been eliminated from that race and such horses also shall not be excluded by elimination when they accept the next time.
- (I) In case a horse is "left in" in a race where additional acceptors are likely to be eliminated, the same horse may be "left in" for any other race on the same day or any other day for which the scratchings are at the same time on the same day, the suitable conditional choices provided shall be selected by the Trainer/ Owner/Authroized Agent in the portal, if the said horse is not eliminated from the other race for which the additional acceptors are likely to be eliminated or the race in question is not divided.
- 12. The Stewards reserve the right to refuse an entry or to cancel an accepted entry at any stage without assigning a reason.
- 13. The Stewards reserve the right to amend or to alter the conditions of any race at any time before the Entry closes and to alter the name of any race after the closing of Entries and to increase the advertised Prize Money for any race prior to Final Forfeits/Scratchings.
- 14. (a) In all Handicaps the lowest weight to be carried shall not be less than 50 kgs. excluding the allowance which a Jockey may claim, if applicable. However, the Handicaps may be framed down to weights below 50 kgs.
 - (b) In races for horses rated 70 and above, the maximum weight an acceptor has to carry shall not exceed 65 kgs.
- 15. Winner of a race after publication of weights in a Handicap race shall carry 5 kgs. extra.
- 16. (a) Minimum top weight in a Handicap race will be 60 kgs. Unless otherwise specified if the highest weight an acceptor has to carry is less than 60 kgs. it shall be raised to 60 kgs. and the other weights shall be raised equally.

- (b) Unless otherwise specified, if the highest weight an acceptor has to carry in a Terms race is less than 55 kgs. it shall be raised to 55 kgs. and the other weights shall be raised equally.
- (c) Unless otherwise specified, Foreign horses will carry 7.5 kgs. more than the weights published in all Terms Races.
- 17. No horse shall carry more than 2 kgs. overweight in any race, except with the permission of the Stewards if the horse is ridden by a Jockey who is either not entitled to claim an allowance or cannot claim an allowance under the conditions of the race. However, in case a horse is ridden by a Jockey claiming an allowance it shall not carry, except with the permission of the Stewards, more than 2 kgs. in excess of the weight which it would have carried if the Jockey in question had claimed in full the allowance to which he was entitled. Such permission must be obtained before the closing of the Starting Declaration.
- 18. Unless otherwise specified, Starting Declarations to be made by the Owner, Trainer or the Authorised Agent, in respect of all horses for all the races must be entered in the portal of www.bangaloreraces.com through their respective accounts, not later than 10 a.m. on the date as published in the Prospectus/Racing Programme/Notice as notified from time to time. Omissions or errors in the Starting Declaration, will render the Owner, Trainer or the Authorised Agent making it, liable to a fine at the discretion of the Stewards.
- 19. (a) Indian Jockeys below 25 years of age and apprentices shall be entitled to claim the following allowances in any handicap flat race.

Not Having ridden 10 winners 4 kgs.
Having ridden 10 winners but not 20 winners 3 kgs.
Having ridden 20 winners but not 30 winners 2 kgs.
Having ridden 30 winners but not 40 winners 1 kg.

No allowance can be claimed after having ridden 40 winners or attaining the age of 25 years whichever is earlier. Notwithstanding the above, a jockey reaching the specified limit of wins as stated above will still be entitled for the allowance originally declared provided the betting for such a race has already opened.

- (b) No rider shall ride in any race, unless he is wearing a Skull Cap, Body Protector of a pattern approved by the Stewards.
- 20. Horses will not be allowed to be led down to the start in advance of the remainder of the field except in very exceptional circumstances, which must be explained to the satisfaction of the Stewards in writing, at least one clear day before the date on which the horse is due to start.
- 21. Colours must be declared with Entries unless already registered under B.T.C. Rules. Where colours are not registered a declaration must be made of the colours to be used at or prior to the time for closing of Forfeits for that day, otherwise a fine may be imposed.

If there be more than one horse of any one Owner left in, in a race, a different coloured cap must be declared for each horse.

Every person running a horse in colours other than those registered or declared as above, may be fined.

In the event of a person being unable to run a horse in colours as declared in the official race card, the Jockey will wear "All Black". A set of these colours may be obtained from the clerk of the Scales.
