BANGALORE WINTER MEETING 2022-23 ELEVENTH DAY, WEDNESDAY, 25th January, 2023

Race: 83. The Gateway of India Plate - Div. II - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45.

An enquiry was held on 28th January, 2023 by the Stipendiary Stewards into the running and riding of ROYAL GRANT, trained by Mr.Narayana Gowda V. and ridden by Jockey P. Kiran Rai in the above race.

Trainer Mr. Narayana Gowda.V and Jockey P. Kiran Rai were interviewed by the Stipendiary Stewards. The Stipendiary Stewards after considering the submissions made by them & after viewing the CCTV replay of the race decided to charge Jockey P. Kiran Rai for Unsatisfactory Riding.

"In that Jockey P. Kiran Rai, the rider of ROYAL GRANT:

- a) Passing the 900 Metres till about 600 Metres he allowed his mount to travel wide for no apparent reason;
- b) The explanations tendered by him for travelling wide was not convincing;
- c) In last 300 Metres the effort on his mount lacks sufficient vigour."

After due deliberations, the Stipendiary Stewards decided as follows:

- a) Noted the explanations tendered by Trainer Mr. Narayana Gowda.V.
- b) To suspend the Jockey's Licence granted to P. Kiran Rai with effect from 10-2-2023 to 5-3-2023 (both days inclusive) for Unsatisfactory Riding on his mount ROYAL GRANT under Rule No. 161 (ii) of the BTC Rules of Racing (he was permitted to ride work) & was informed of his right to appeal.

ELEVENTH DAY, WEDNESDAY, 25th January, 2023

Race: 88. The National Tourism Day Plate - Div. I - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 6 years old and over (Whips not allowed).

It was reported after the race that QUEEN REGNANT (Mohammed Aliyar) pulled up lame on left hind. Trainer Mr. Aravind G. was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

TWELFTH DAY, THURSDAY, 26th January, 2023

Race: 90. The Saddle Up Plate - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 00 to 25.

An enquiry was held on 28th January, 2023 into the running and riding of CHIRAAG, trained by Mr. Mahmood Khan and ridden by Jockey Chandrashekar .M in the above race.

Trainer Mr. Mahmood Khan and Jockey Chandrashekar. M were interviewed by the Stipendiary Stewards. The Stipendiary Stewards after considering the submissions made by them & after viewing the CCTV replay of the race decided to charge Jockey Chandrashekar .M for Unsatisfactory Riding.

"In that Jockey Chandrashekar. M, the rider of CHIRAAG:

- a) Made no effort to positioning his mount as instructed by the trainer;
- b) Made a feeble attempt after passing the 400 Metres till the winning post;
- c) Despite the lack of efforts his mount it finished a good fourth".

After due deliberations, the Stipendiary Stewards decided as follows:

- a) Noted the explanations tendered by Trainer Mr. Mahmood Khan.
- b) To suspend the Jockey's Licence granted to Chandrashekar. M with effect from10-2-2023 to 5-3-2023 (both days inclusive) for Unsatisfactory Riding on his mount CHIRAAG under Rule No. 161 (ii) of the BTC Rules of Racing (he was permitted to ride work) & was informed of his right to appeal.
